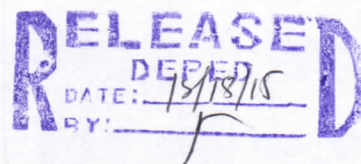



2015 EDUCATION WEEK

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 2399 dated February 25, 1985 Designating the Second Week of December of Every Year as Education Week, the Department of Education (DepEd) shall celebrate the **2015 Education Week** nationwide with the theme *Discovering Choices, Creating Opportunities* from December 7 to 11, 2015.

2. The Celebration aims to:

- provide awareness among stakeholders on the role of education as a stimulus towards national development;
- reaffirm and emphasize the role of education in empowering and developing the young to be productive citizens of the country and responsive to the needs of the times;
- drum up support and cooperation among stakeholders for the implementation of the Enhanced Basic Education Program (K to 12);
- strengthen cooperation among stakeholders in education to support the necessary and significant changes to achieve quality and relevant education; and
- inspire every educator to do more for the learners to ensure their future.

3. Regional directors (RDs) and schools division superintendents (SDSs) are enjoined to take an active lead in this week-long Celebration.

4. All school officials are encouraged to conduct simple programs and activities during the week consistent with the theme and objectives of this year's celebration. Enclosed is the suggested list of activities, which may be conducted in all DepEd offices and schools by concerned officials and school heads, teaching and non-teaching personnel.

5. Necessary arrangements shall be made to ensure that teachers, and learners shall participate in the Celebration without any disruption of classes as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.*

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6. Expenses relative to the conduct of activities during the week-long celebration shall be charged to local funds of the concerned offices and schools, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. All regional offices shall submit a report on the conduct of activities celebrating the 2015 Education Week on or before January 15, 2016 through email: communications@deped.gov.ph.
