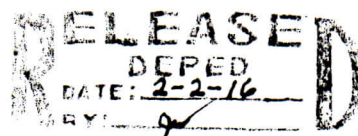

Subject: Manik-Aninong Dulaan (Shadow Puppetry)

In line with the Arts Month Celebration 2016 through Presidential Proclamation No. 683 s. 1991, which aims to promote Philippine Arts and popularize outstanding creations of Dagupan Artists in Visual Arts and Theater Arts through Filipino creativity and imagination, the Dagupan City Culture and Arts Office in partnership with the Department of Education through Dagupan City National High School will conduct the Manik-Aninong Dulaan (Shadow Puppetry).

At the end of the said event, it is expected that;

- a. Participants will appreciate the value of our culture and arts in the community;
- b. The learners will become fully aware of their roles in taking care of the environment;
- c. Participants will learn shadow puppetry making and perform shadow puppetry; and
- d. Multimedia-skills will be incorporated to age-old art form.

For the workshop & exhibit, each District and Private school should submit list of participants on or before February 8, 2016 at the Culture and Arts Office City Museum.

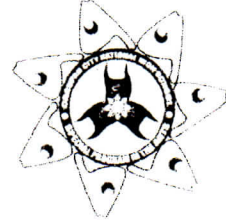

Kalikasan... Tunay na Yaman

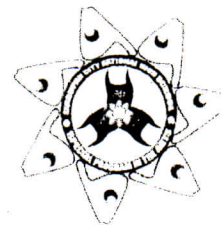

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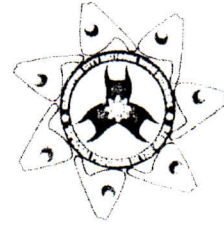

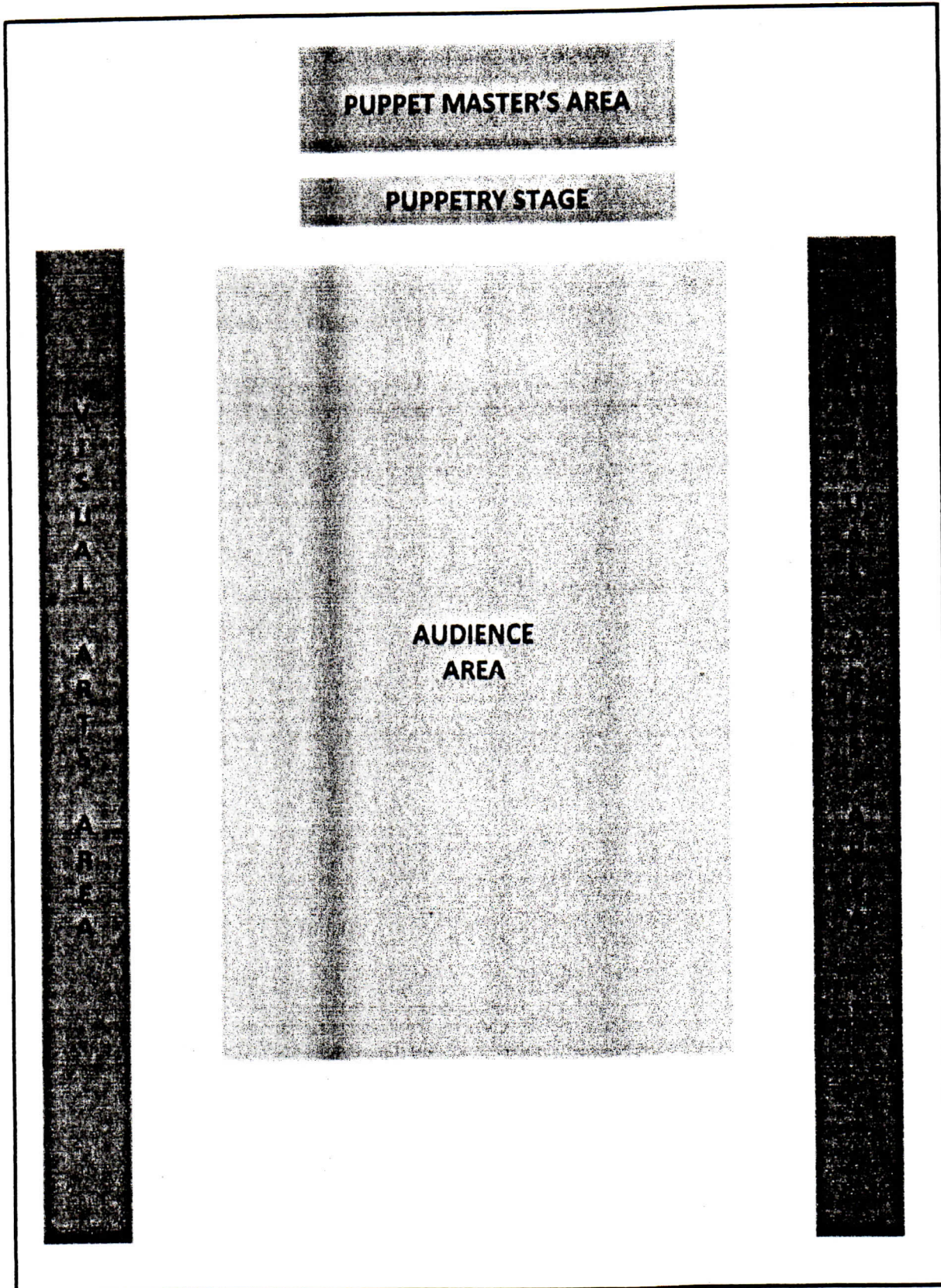
