SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY CARAVAN

1. The City Government of Dagupan and Department of Science and Technology (DOST) is proud to announce the conduct of the Science and Technology Caravan on March 27 - 29, 2017 at the CSI Atrium.
2. The caravan aims to forge a stronger partnership and collaboration between the Local Government Unit of Dagupan City and the DOST and raise awareness and appreciation on the programs and projects of DOST through the S&T exhibits, fora, interactive exhibits, among others.
3. Aside from exhibits and technology fora, DOST will also feature different activities for our teachers and students in Dagupan City which will include the following:
 - a). Information campaign on DOST Scholarships and Starbooks (March 27, 1:00-2:30 PM)
 - b). Poster making contest for public elementary and high school students.

 - c). Interactive science centrum exhibits, science magic and film viewing

4. Attached are the guidelines for the poster-making contest, schedule of activities and number of participants for the elementary and secondary schools both public and private schools.

Mechanics and Criteria for the POSTER MAKING CONTEST

This Poster Making Contest is part of the SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY CARAVAN to involve the artistically inclined pupils and students of Dagupan City. It will be held on March 27, 2017, 2:30 – 4:00 P.M. at the Main Atrium of CSI The City Mall.

1. The Public Elementary and Secondary Schools are encouraged to send three (3) elementary pupils per district and one (1) student representative per high schools who shall create a poster depicting the theme of the Science and Technology caravan.
2. For the Elementary category, it will focus on the theme "Science for the People" while "Smart Dagupan City" will be the focus of the Secondary school entries.
3. Materials during the contest shall be provided for each of the participants which include $\frac{1}{4}$ illustration board, pencil with eraser and oil pastel coloring. No other materials are allowed except the ones provided by the committee.
4. Posters shall be adjudged based on creativity and presentation, originality, and clear depiction of the theme.
5. First, Second and Third Placers shall be chosen among the entries for each category who will be receiving prizes and certificates of recognition. Non-winning participants shall be given consolation prizes and individual certificates of appreciation.
