This is conducted with the aim of contributing to the holistic development of our boys through scouting and to the formation and producing self-less dependable and most of all, God-fearing Leaders and Citizens of our society in the years to come. This is also in preparation for the coming scouting activities for the Scouting Month in October.

A training fee of six hundred fifty pesos (Php 650.00) will be charged to each participant for Patrol Leaders Training Course and seven hundred fifty pesos (Php 750.00) will be charged to each participant for Crew Leaders Training Course to defray the expenses for meals, snacks, certificates and training materials.
- 4. Participants are required to wear Scout Neckerchief with carabao slide. Furthermore, they should come in casual attire (white shirt and pants) and comfortable shoes. Appropriate attire should be observed all the time. Opening Ceremonies will start at 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon Closing Ceremonies will be on Sunday at 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon.
- Things to bring: neckerchief, carabao slide, sleeping gears, toiletries, extra clothes, shorts, slippers, rubber shoes
- 6. The teacher participants in the training shall be entitled to service credit in accordance with DO 53, s.2003 entitled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*. On the other hand, non-teaching staff shall be provided with *Compensatory Time-Off* (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 entitled *Non-Monetary Remuneration of Overtime Service Rendered*.


