

DAGUPAN CITY ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (DCAA) 3x3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

- The Department of Education Schools Division Office through DCAA in partnership with Dagupan City Government through DCSC will conduct a One-day 3x3 Basketball Tournament, to select the participants to the R1AA 2018.
- 2. The objectives of the tournament are: to foster closer relationship and camaraderie among players, students/pupils, officials, coaches and schools, to promote the spirit of sportsmanship and fair play, to develop basic skills and fundamentals of sports, and to brace athletes for higher meets and international competitions.
- The said event will be on November 23, 2017, Thursday, 7:30 A.M. at Peoples' City Astrodome.
- 4. The Tournament is OPEN to all Elementary and Secondary schools (public/private). See attached Tournament Guidelines, Rules of the Game and List of Management, Technical Staff and Officials.
- All concerned are enjoined to support the program and encourage the players, coaches and
 referees to participate actively in order to achieve the objectives of the program.
- 6. Immediate and widest dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

3X3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES:

- Only schools which joined the just concluded Mayor Belen Cup 2017 DCAA Basketball
 Tournament will be allowed to compete (for availability and readiness of athletes' documents).
- Each participating team (elementary boys and secondary boys & girls) shall have three

 (3) main players and one (1) alternate player. For interested schools, please submit the name of your school with the list of your players and parent's permit to Sir Isagani D.
 Rosario at SGOD Office, SDO, Dagupan City on or before November 22, 2017 (Wed.)
 11:00 A.M.

Coaches' meeting will follow at 1:00 P.M. @ City People's Astrodome, Dagupan City.

- 3. The same special rules, guidelines and regulations of the DCAA Basketball Tournament as well as the latest FIBA Rules and knock out system shall be applied.
- 4. The BEST team (CHAMPION) in each category will receive a trophy. Eight (8) players will be chosen for the training pool and the final four (4) will represent our City Division in R1AA Meet 2018. Any chosen player who refuses to participate in the R1AA without valid reason/s shall be banned to participate in any future DepEd tournament.

RULES OF THE GAME:

Tournament Format

Teams to be divided into two (2) brackets

Each bracket to play a single elimination (knock-out)

No. 1 teams in each bracket to vie for the championship

Team roster

4 players

3 + 1 substitute

Note: game must start with 3 (three) players in FIBA 3x3 Official

1 or 2

Referee(s)

Up to 2

Time-outs

Scoring

1 per team and 2 TV-time outs, if any, at first dead ball after

6:59 and 3:59 dead ball, 30 seconds

Initial possession

Coin flip Note: the team that wins the coin flip decides whether

it takes the ball or leaves it, in order to get it in a potential

overtime

1 point and 2 points, if scored behind the arc

Game duration & Score limit

1 x 10 minutes, playing time Score limit: 21 points. Applies to regular playing time only Note: if a game clock is not available, running time length and sudden death score is at organizer's discretion. FIBA recommends setting score limit in line with the game duration (10 minutes/10 points; 15 minutes/15 points; 21

minutes/21 points)

First team to score two (2) points wins the game

Overtime

Shot clock

12 seconds Note: if a shot clock device is not available , referee

to warn and count down the 5 last seconds

Free throw(s) following a shooting foul

1 free throw 2 free throws, if foul committed behind the arc

Foul limit per team

6 team fouls
2 free throws

Penalty for team fouls 7, 8 and 9
Penalty for team fouls 10 and more

2 free throws + ball possession

Possession following a successful goal

Defense possession Right underneath the hoop Ball to be dribbled or passed to a player behind the arc Defensive team not allowed to play for the ball inside the "no-charge semi-

circle" area underneath the basket

...following a dead ball

Check ball exchange behind the arc (at the top)

...following a defensive rebound or steal

Ball to be dribbled/passed behind the arc

...following a jump ball situation

Defense possession

Substitutions

In dead ball situations, prior to the check ball The substitute can enter the game after his teammate steps off the court and establishes a physical contact with him behind the end line opposite the basket. Substitutions require no action from the referees or table officials
