Date: October 31, 2017

1. Due to the overwhelming clamor of the participants of the international seminar last October hosted by Schools Division Office - Dagupan City, Global Educators Network-Teachers of English as a Foreign Language (GEN TEFL) will conduct an international seminar on **RESEARCH: Planning, Development and Design on December 1-3, 2017 at Leisure Coast Resort, Dagupan City.**

(GEN TFL is a non-profit network for educators in the field of English Language Teaching based in Thailand.

It is an associate of the International Association of Teachers of English as a Foreign Language (IATEFL) based in the United Kingdom. Their mission is to enrich the lives of educators, administrators, teachers, researchers, and students through research, conference meetings, seminars and workshops. The association is committed to promote the goals and objectives of the Department of Education in the conduct of teacher-training programs geared towards quality outcome based education.)

The president of GEN TEFL will select 10 best research titles. The approved abstracts will be presented during the Int'l. Seminar-Workshop. Research mentors will be provided to guide the winning researchers until they finish the research work to be published in a special edition of GEN TEFL Journal.

In addition, one best paper presenter will be chosen (sponsored registration fee) to attend the 3rd GEN TEFL International Conference to be held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on 11-13, May 2018.

Freebies such as printers, flash drives and t-shirts will also be given thru a raffle draw.
