





Subject : SEARCH FOR BEST GULAYAN SA PAARALAN

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Learners Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), strengthens the implementation of the Gulayan sa Paaralan Program(GPP)for Public Elementary and Secondary Schools nationwide to address malnutrition, promote vegetable production / consumption among school children and to ensure continuous supply of vegetables for the School - Based Feeding Program.
2. The general objective of the GPP is to promote food security to schools and communities through self-help food production activities and values among the learners and appreciation of agriculture as life support system.
3. Schools Division Office initiates Search for Best Gulayan sa Paaralan. Three winners will be chosen from the participating schools.
4. The Division Evaluation Team is composed of the following :
 - a. Chairman : Schools Division Superintendent
 - b. Vice-Chairman : Asst. Schools Division Superintendent
 - c. Member: Mr. Robert De Vera
5. In line with this the preliminary evaluation for the Search for Best Gulayan sa Paaralan will be on November 27-29, 2017 and final evaluation will be on December 11-14, 2017.
6. For the schedule of evaluation for the Search for Best Gulayan sa Paaralan are the following:

Preliminary Evaluation:

November 27, 2017 - Dist. I, II & III
November 28, 2017 - Dist. IV, V & VI
November 29, 2017 - Dist. VII, VIII, IX & X

Final Evaluation:

December 11, 2017 - Dist. I, II & III
December 12, 2017 - Dist. IV & V
December 13, 2017 - Dist. VI, VII & VIII
December 14, 2017 - Dist. IX & X

7. School heads are enjoined to extend full administrative support for the successful management of the program.
8. Attached is the criteria for judging the Best Gulayan sa Paaralan.
9. Submission of official entries (thru letter of confirmation of the school head) from each district will be on or before November 10, 2017.
10. Winners will receive cash prize.
10. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.

SCOPE AND CRITERIA**

A. GULAYAN SA PAARALAN (70%)

1. Presence of Vegetable Garden (15%)

- Leafy / Green Vegetables (minimum of 7 varieties)
- Fruits / pods/ legumes
- Root Crops
- Herbal Medicinal Plants (minimum of 10 varieties)
- Overall landscaping of the school

2. Adaptation of different Strategies/ Technologies (10%)

- Bio Intensive Gardening
- Organic Pest Management
- Organic Fertilizer

3. Urban Gardening (Containerized Gardening) (10%)

- At least 50 container with 5 kinds each = 10 points)

4. Contribution to the School feeding program per H.E feeding program report (5%)

5. Presence of School Nursery and Garden House (10%)

6. Proper labeling of seeding planted with signage/tag (5%)

7. Accessibility and sufficiency of water supply (10%)

8. Keep and Submit Updated Report (5%)

B. AQUA CULTURE (10%)

1. Fishpond (7%)
2. Fish-in-tank (3%)

C. LIVESTOCK (10%)

1. Poultry (8%) minimum 50 heads
2. Plus Factor (2%) – at least 5 heads of goats/2 heads pig and a head of cattle

D. Innovation (10%)
