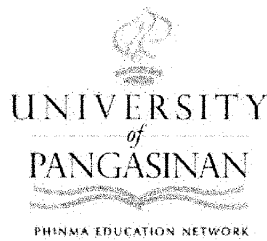
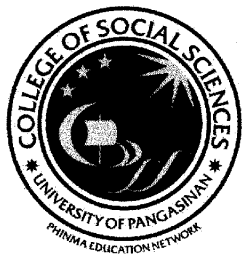

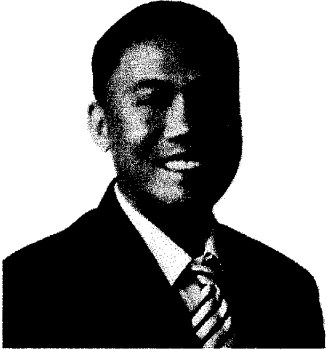

### **SPEAKERS' PROFILES**



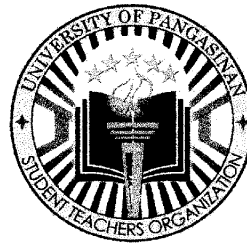
#### **1. MR. RANDY H. HALASAN**

A recipient of the 2014 Ramon Magsaysay Award for Emergent Leadership.

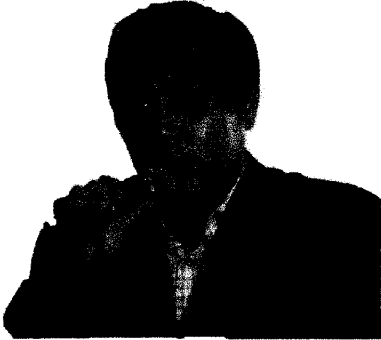
He travels seven hours from his family's home in the city – two hours by bus, an hour over extremely rough roads by habal-habal motorcycle, four hours of walking, and crossing the waters of two treacherous rivers – to reach Pegalongan Elementary School, a two-room schoolhouse, teaching multi-grade classes between Grades 1 and 6 to serve the Matigsalug tribe.

Recognizing that poverty is the community's fundamental problem, Halasan has taken his advocacy beyond the classroom. He says, “If I only focus on education, nothing will happen; the children will continue to go hungry.” Envisioning a food-sufficient community, he inspired his fellow-teachers to donate seeds and encouraged the villagers to plant fruit trees and vegetables. Working with the Pegalongan Farmers Association, he accessed assistance from private organizations and government agencies. Prodded and encouraged by his leadership, Pegalongan farmers now have a collectively-owned rice-and-corn mill, a seed bank, a cattle dispersal project, and horses for transporting their farm products. The village is also now participating in a government forest rehabilitation program which by 2014 will have a hundred forested hectares, with the Matigsalug of Pegalongan as stewards and beneficiaries. And Halasan's youthful graduates are helping their elders protect their future and the legal rights to their ancestral domain.

The Ramon Magsaysay Award Foundation board of trustees recognizes *“his purposeful dedication in nurturing his Matigsalug students and their community to transform their lives through quality education and sustainable livelihoods, doing so in ways that respect their uniqueness and preserve their integrity as indigenous peoples in a modernizing Philippines.”*



## 2. DR. JOSEPH V. JOVELLANOS



He earned her Bachelors of Arts degree in Philosophy at Saint Louis University where he graduated as Magna cum laude. He continued his development earning his Master of Arts in Education graduating as a cum laude. In his professional growth he pursued his Bachelor of Laws at Saint Louis University and at PHINMA University of Pangasinan. Recently, he obtained his doctorate degree in Education major in Higher Education at PHINMA University of Pangasinan.

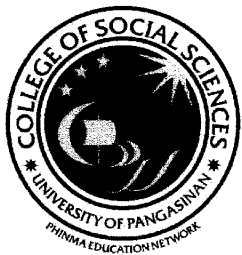
He is currently the President of Samahang Manggagawang Pilipino – National Alliance of Teachers and Office Workers (SMP-NATOW) with its central office at Mandaluyong City. Similarly he is the President of the University of Pangasinan Faculty Union.

His affiliations to other organizations include his membership in Council of Leaders, Trade Union of the Philippines at Quezon City, Fraternitas et Sororitas Lex Libertatis, Inc. (A Law Fraternity) at Baguio City, ULUPAN: Association for the Preservation of the Pangasinan Language at Lingayen Pangasinan, and Education International with its regional office located at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia and central office at Brussels, Belgium.

His published materials include “Training Modules on Post-Yolanda Rehabilitation Initiative: A Handbook” published by Education International, “The Teacher and The Law: A Legal Guide for Teachers” published by Education International and The Swedish Teacher Union, “The Socius: An Introduction to Social Philosophy”, “A Philosophical Journey Towards Self-Understanding”, and “The Philippine Government with the 1987 Constitution: An Instructional Model” among others.

He attended various seminars and fora which include “8th Education International Asia-Pacific Regional Conference” held at Kathmandu, Nepal, “Seminar-Workshop on Strengthening Social Dialogue” by International Trade Union Confederation at Bangkok, Thailand, “Training on Advocacy Development” at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, and “Leadership Education and Exchange” by Japan International Labor Foundation at Tokyo, Japan among others.

He is also a Panel Member at different conventions which include “Regional Symposium on Worker’s Rights in Global Supply Chains” at Dhaka, Bangladesh, “Safety and Security in Schools at Education” International 7th World Congress held at Ottawa, Canada, and “Education For All Monitoring Report 2015” by UNESCO at Bangkok, Thailand among others.

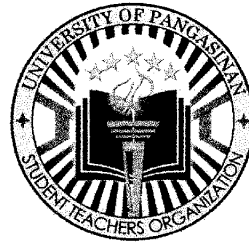
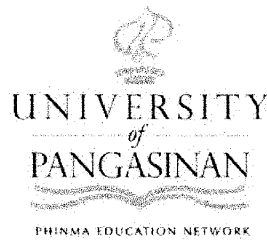


### **3. DR. NENITA V. HABULAN**

She earned her Bachelor's degree in Education major in speech and drama from University of San Agustin in Iloilo City. She continued her growth by earning her Master's Degree in Educational technology from the University of the Philippines-Diliman, where is a member of UP Honour Society. Her pursuit of development led her to achieving her Doctorate degree in Educational Leadership and Management from De La Salle University-Manila where she graduated with "high distinction".

She has scripted and produced video documentaries and other instructional materials in the late 1990's. Her patriotism and pride for our country, the Philippines, can be clearly seen in one of her notable works an interactive multimedia CD entitled "The Historic Journey in the Philippines" which is today included in the library collection of Yale University, Cornell University and in the University of Hawaii in United States of America.

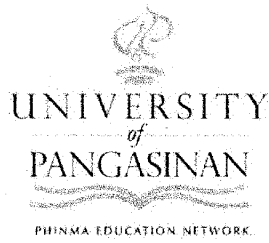
