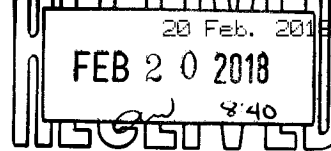

**37<sup>th</sup> PRINCIPALS TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AND  
 NATIONAL BOARD CONFERENCE**

1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) will hold the **37<sup>th</sup> Principals Training and Development Program and National Board Conference (PTD-NBC)** with the theme *PESPAs: The Catalyst of Change for a Better 21<sup>st</sup> Century Educational Management* from May 4 to 6, 2018 at SMX Convention Center, SM Lanang Premier, J.P. Laurel Ave., Agdao, Davao City, 8000 Davao del Sur.
2. The Conference aims to:
  - a. identify the School Heads' desired skills on vocal image, his conversational manners, proper posture, and attire for enhanced interpersonal relationship in the work place;
  - b. strengthen the 21<sup>st</sup> century skills of School Heads on the areas of critical thinking and in problem-solving;
  - c. enhance knowledge of pertinent legal issues on K to 12, rules on appointments and the duties of school heads; and,
  - d. raise the commitments of participants to implement whatever knowledge and skills gained in the training seminar in their respective Regions.
3. The target participants are elementary school heads/principals, teachers-in-charge of public/private elementary schools nationwide, and PESPA officers and board members. Attendance of participants shall be on official business.
4. A Registration Fee of Five Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P5,500.00) shall be charged to each participant to cover meals, conference kit and other related expenses, chargeable to Human Resource Training and Development (HRTD) Funds and School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) allocation for training and travelling expenses, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Arrival and registration of participants will be on **May 4, 2018**. The first meal to be served will be dinner on the day 1, and the last meal will be lunch on the last day of the conference.
