





Motorcade route

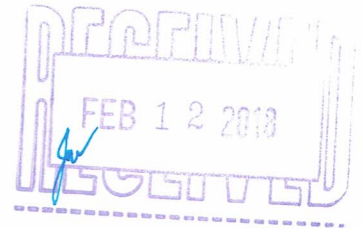

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: MECHANICS OF GAMES AND CONTESTS FOR CY 2018
OBSERVANCE OF FIRE PREVENTION MONTH

DATE : 07 February 2018

1. Reference:

- a. Memorandum duly signed by **FIRE DIRECTOR LEONARD R BAÑAGO (DSC) Chief, BFP** dated 24 January 2018 re: above subject.
- b. Memorandum from the office of the Assistant Regional Director for Operations, SUPT FLORO L OBRERO dated 31 January 2018 re: above subject received by this office on 06 February 2018.

2. ICOW the above-mentioned reference, hereunder are the official mechanics for CY 2018 Fire Prevention Month Games and Contests, to wit;

1. Only one entry for each category shall be allowed to be submitted to this office from the stations as their official entry. In case of tie, the City/Municipal Fire Marshal or his authorized representative shall choose only one winner which shall serve as its official entry. All entries from station Level shall be forwarded to this office (**ATTN: Provincial OPN Section**) **NLT February 28, 2018**, which shall conform to the mechanics stated below

3. Entries shall strictly observe the following set of mechanics:

- a) **Essay Writing Contest - Open to Junior High School Students (Grade 7-10)**
 - Must be written (handwritten) in a yellow pad paper using black ball pen to be provided by the BFP.
 - Composition must not exceed 750 words and must be written in English;
 - All entries must have relevance with this year's Fire Prevention Month Theme/Slogan - "Ligtas na Pilipinas ang Atang Hangad, Pag-iingat sa Sunog ay sa Sarili Ipatupad";

- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title of the essay which shall be attached at the back of their entry;
- All participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID;
- The BFP has the right to publish the winning entry of its official gazette; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and not appealable.

b) Drawing Contest- Open to Elementary Pupils (Grade 1-6)

- Must be drawn/illustrated in a 12 x 18 inches illustration board (**PORTRAIT LAYOUT** – Size shall be strictly observed, otherwise entry will be disqualified) using crayon or oil pastel to be provided by the BFP;
- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title with brief description of the drawing entry which shall be attached at the back of their entry;
- All participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID;
- All entries must have relevance with this year's Fire Prevention Month Theme/Slogan;
- No identifying marks shall be allowed in all entries;
- All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted into any size of exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said drawing/illustration; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and not appealable

c) Poster Making Contest - Open to Junior and Senior High School Students (Grade 7-12)

- Must be drawn/illustrated in a 12x 18 inches illustration board (**PORTRAIT LAYOUT** – Sizes shall be strictly observed, otherwise entry will be disqualified) using water color to be provided by the BFP;
- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title with brief description of the poster which shall be attached at the back of their entry. Likewise, all participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID;
- All entries must have relevance with this year's Fire prevention Month Theme/Slogan;
- No identifying marks shall be allowed in all entries;
- Photos of the Poster in JPEG format shall be sent to bfpr1opndiv@yahoo.com by the Provincial Offices, however must still be properly endorsed in hard copy duly signed by the concerned Provincial Fire Marshal;
- All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted into any size of

- exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said drawing/illustration; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and not appealable.

d) Photo Contest – Open to all Amateur Photographers

- Must be submitted in “8 x 10” or 8R (**PORTRAIT LAYOUT** – Sizes shall be strictly observed, otherwise entry will be disqualified) full color print together with digital file of JPEG format (CD) or E-mail at bfpr1opndiv@yahoo.com;
- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title with brief description of the photo entry which shall be attached at the back of their entry;
- All entries must be taken in the Philippines and must not be digitally edited or augmented;
- Photos in JPEG format sent to bfpr1opndiv@yahoo.com by the Provincial Offices, however must still be properly endorsed to this office in hard copy duly signed by the concerned Provincial Fire Marshal;
- All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/ or reprinted into any size of exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said photos; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and not appealable.

e) Battle of the Bands (Original Composition)

- Open to all BFP officers and personnel; no age limit and must compete in a group with a minimum of five members and a maximum of eight;
- Bands shall submit an advance copy of the lyrics and a recorded demo (HD Video on DVD) of their contest piece to this office seven (7) days prior to the actual competition. Composition must be anchored on this year's theme slogan;
- The original composition shall have at most of (5) minutes in full length. Each band shall be given 5 minutes to adjust/tune the instruments to be used. For every exceeding minute on the allowed timeframe, the band be penalized of 2 points from their total score;
- All band members must refrain from using any offensive forms of communication while on stage. Lyrics must not include swearing, derogatory, inappropriate or sexually explicit languages or those considered offensive to anyone, in any way;
- All bands members are discouraged to wear any clothing that may depict any pictures or languages that may be deemed offensive; and
- All performing bands should be present on time and must refrain from loitering prior to their performance; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and not appealable.

4. Criteria for judging. The following criteria for each category shall be observed:

a) Essay Writing Contest

- **Theme Relevance** - 40%
 - Does it demonstrate a clear understanding of the theme?
 - Does it clearly relate to the topic?
 - Is it accurate and logical?
- **Presentation and Persuasion** - 30%
 - Is the grammar, spelling and punctuations correct?
 - Is the article neatly written and has well-constructed paragraphs?
- **Creativity** - 30%
 - Are the ideas presented original?
 - Is there innovative ways of thinking?
 - Does the writer dream outside the box?
 - Is there evidence of convincing and coherent line of argument?
 - Does the essay inspire the reader and move them to action?

b) Drawing contest

- **Theme Relevance** - 40%
 - Does the poster effectively communicate the CY 2018 Fire Prevention Month theme?
- **Creativity and Originality** - 30%
 - Does the poster demonstrate creativity and originality?
- **Aesthetic Appeal** - 30%
 - Does the poster design captivate the judges' sense, taking into account the principle of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion?

c) Photo Contest

- **Theme Relevance** - 40%
 - Does the photo effectively communicate the CY 2018 Fire Prevention Month theme?
- **Composition** - 20%
 - Are the items of interest placed well in the photo?
- **Creativity** - 20%
 - Is the subject matter pictured in a unique way or is a common item shown from an interesting point-of-view?
 - Does the photo demonstrate originality?
- **Technical Quality** - 10%
 - Is the photo in focus?
 - Is lighting balance?
 - Is the shutter speed varied or adjusted to be appropriate for the photo?
- **Overall impression** - 10%
 - Is the photo able to grab the viewer's attention?
 - Are there any special effects?

d) Poster Making Contest

- **Theme Relevance** - 40%
Does the poster effectively communicate the CY 2018 Fire Prevention Month theme?
- **Creativity and Originality** - 30%
Does the poster demonstrate creativity and originality?
- **Aesthetic Appeal** - 30%
Does the poster design captivate the judges' sense, taking into account the principle of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion?

100%

e) Battle of the Bands

- **Musicality (clarity, lyrical, content, quality of performance)** - 40%
 - Confidence/ competence. Does the band look at ease and know very well what they are doing/playing?
 - Material. How unique is the sound of the song? Does it conform to the theme?
Delivery. Was it sung and delivered with clarity?
- **Stage Presence and Crowd Interaction (style)** - 30%
How does the band rock out or how well they interact with the audience?
Are they confident in their interaction with the audience or they appear positive and enjoying their performance?
Did they use the stage effectively?
- **Originality** - 20%
Does the song fit the theme and the genre?
Does the band stand out from the rest? Does it look and sound as original?
Does the band demonstrate any level of original improvisational skill (vocal thru an instrument)?

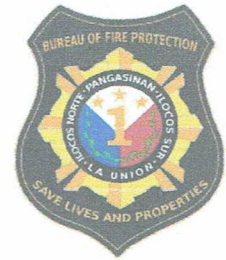

Maze Runner

“Can you handle the heat? Try to survive a burning obstacle”

Introduction

Games offer a unique structure to complement traditional teaching strategies and infuse teaching with energy, spark innovative thinking and provide diversity in teaching methods. Games make learning concepts more palatable for students and supply learners with a platform for their creative thoughts to bounce around. Games encourage creative behavior and divergent thought. Games will often act as learning triggers inducing lively discussion on learning concepts amongst students following game play.

Materials

Tire	: 20 pcs
Straw	: 3 rolls
Box	: 50 Large Boxes
Fire Extinguisher	: 10 pcs
Packing Tape	: 10 pcs
Bamboo	: 5 pcs
Plywood	: 10 pcs
Half drum	: 4 pcs

Gasoline	: 20 Liters

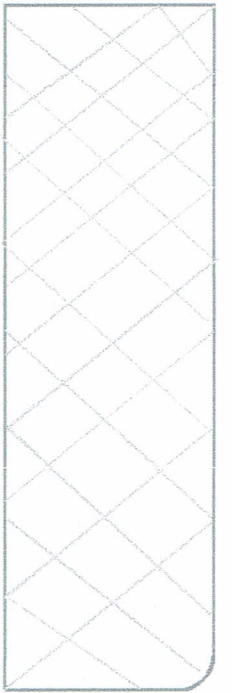

Mechanics

1. Before entering to the obstacle a Safety orientation will be conducted in starting line by a Fire officer
2. A minimum of five (5) and maximum of ten (10) participants before the game will start.
3. Each batch will be given 15 mins to finish the obstacle
4. There are different stages that participants must face before finishing the obstacle.
 - 4.a. Stage 1: **Spiders Web** – If you have to escape a fire through smoke, crawl low, keeping your head 12 to 24 inches (30 to 60 centimeters) above the floor, where the air is cleaner. Participants must crawl until he/she reaches the safe zone.
 - 4.b. Stage 2: **Zero Visibility Escape**: Fire Generate smoke that will cause total darkness in a room participants will enter to a maze that is in total darkness. Participants must escape the maze without getting hurt or injured.
 - 4.c. Stage 3: **Tire Obstacle** – A fun workout that uses aerobic movements to lift your heart rate and burn calories. To keep the body in good health is a duty... otherwise we shall not be able to keep our mind strong and clear. Participants must finish the tire obstacle before going to the next activity
 - 4.d Stage 4. **Escape plan** - Make a home escape plan and hold regular fire drills so everyone in your household knows what to do in a fire emergency. When escaping a fire, you must know where your nearest exit is. You must familiarize the FLOOR Plan Before entering to any kind of buildings/ establishment.
5. At the end of every obstacle a fire officer will teach different lessons/ techniques/ activities that a fire fighter must possess.
 - 5.a . Donning of Personal Protective Equipment
 - 5.b. Knot tying
 - 5.c. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation
 - 5.d. Use of Fire Extinguisher



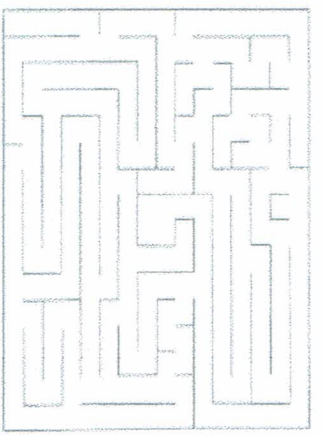

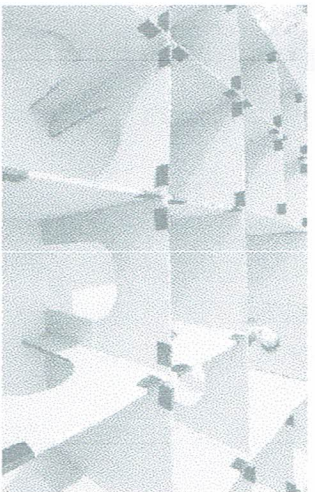

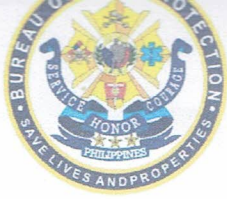
