1. The contest is open to all public and private elementary schools in Dagupan City.

CONTEST RULES AND MECHANICS (AWARAN)

- Contestants shall be provided with pen and paper to be utilized during the contest proper. Such paper shall be collected by the assigned monitor every after category/round.
- 3. English and Pangasinan shall be the official languages to be used in the conduct of the contest.
- 4. There will be a total of twenty (20) questions to be given, six (6) of which are easy questions, seven (7) are average, and seven (7) are difficult.
- 5. Each question shall be read twice by the quizmaster.
- 6. The contestants shall be given a maximum of (20) seconds to answer questions that require long answers; other questions shall be given ten (10) seconds.
- 7. Should contestant desire to change his/her answer that has already been written, said answer should be struck out with a horizontal line, and the new answer shall be written clearly above or below the changed answer. A contestant is allowed to change his/her answer within the allotted time to answer a particular question.
- 8. Points for every correct answer shall be: one (1) point for easy question, two (2) for an average question, and three (3) for difficult question.
- 9. Champion shall be proclaimed based on the cumulative scoring system.
