ADMINISTRATION OF THE REVISED PHILIPPINE INFORMAL READING INVENTORY (PHIL - IRI) 2018

1. The Division office announces the Administration of the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory 2018 as stipulated in <u>DO 14</u>, s. 2018 - Policy Guidelines on the Administration of the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory.

Hence, all public elementary school heads are advised to download the manual and instruct one English teacher per grade (Gr 4-6 only) and one Filipino teacher per grade (Gr 3-6 only) to attend an <u>orientation</u> on the conduct of the said activity on <u>June 22 at the Division Training Center, 1pm.</u>

2. The Phil-IRI data must serve as one of the bases in planning, designing/redesigning the reading instruction of the teachers and the school's reading programs or activities to improve the school's overall reading performance.

Moreover, all elementary and secondary school heads are expected to adopt the following as advised by USEC Lorna Dig Digno on Brigada for Every Child a Reader right after the conduct of the PHIL-IRI.

- Present the reading data (minus learners' names) during the first Homeroom PTA meeting. Based on the data presented, request stakeholders during this meeting to co- create projects or activities that will improve reading comprehension skills of learners.
 - Conduct Learning Action Cell (LAC).

Coach/mentor all teachers from K to 12 to be reading teachers. Develop at least the following skills: note details, infer and apply knowledge and skills.

- 3. Results of PHIL-IRI (Pretest) including School-based Action Plan on Enhancement/Remedial Programs and Proposed LAC must be submitted to EPS Bacugan (English) and EPS Erfelo (Filipino) on or before <u>August 3</u>.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
