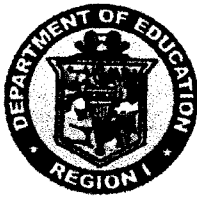
Subject: **29<sup>th</sup> NATIONAL STATISTICS MONTH CELEBRATION**

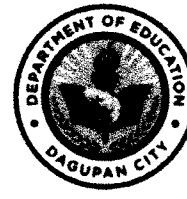
1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647, issued on September 20, 1990, the month of October of every year is declared as the National Statistics Month (NSM).

### **DIVISION CONTEST GUIDELINES**

*Name of the Contest* : **STATISTICS QUIZ**

*Date & Time* : September 27, 2018 8:00 A.M.

*Venue* : Dagupan City National High School

*Participants* : One (1) Team of three (3) enrolled High School students regardless of grade level per school.

*Conduct of the Competition:*

1. All contestants will take a written multiple choice type test.
2. The duration of the test is one (1) hour.
3. When the papers have been corrected, the scores of the three contestants of a school shall be added to form the school's score.
4. The schools' scores will be ranked from highest to lowest.
5. The team from the highest scoring school will represent the division in the Provincial Level.
6. The decision of the board of judges is final.
