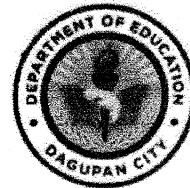

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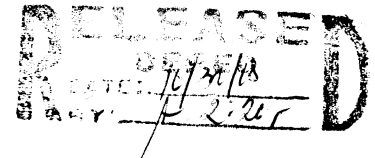

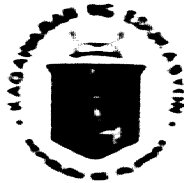
SUBJECT : CONDUCT OF CY 2018 FOURTH QUARTER NATIONAL
SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL 2017

DATE : October 31, 2018



1. This is to inform the field of the conduct of the CY 2018 Fourth Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill and Observance of World Tsunami Awareness Day, as per Department of Education Memorandum Dated October 22, 2018. This is also in compliance with the DepEd Order No. 48, S. 2012, which enjoins all public and private schools to conduct of Quarterly National School-Based Earthquake Drills.
2. All Public Schools District Supervisors are requested to ensure school compliance to this endeavor. Meanwhile, the conduct of the earthquake drill in the Division shall be taken charge by the Top Management through both Chief ES-SGOD and Chief ES-CID.
3. Objectives of the CY2018 Q4 NSED are the following: a) To evaluate the readiness and awareness of learners and DepEd personnel for earthquakes; and b) to evaluate coordination and communication mechanisms during evacuation procedures and response and shall intensify advocacy on World Tsunami Awareness Day.
4. Herewith is the list of things to do in preparation for the earthquake drill;
 - a) Connect with DepEd DRRM Partner agencies (e.g. City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (CDRRMC), BFP, PNP Or Philippine Red Cross-Dagupan City Chapter, PNP-Maritime, PANDA and other) for Disaster Preparedness Advocacy Session and for post evaluation of the earthquake drill.
 - b) Map out personnel/learners and contact numbers.
 - c) Determine communication flow among office/schools and overall command system.
 - d) Determine personnel/learners with special needs in case of an earthquake; assign focal persons within the particular office/classroom to take charge of those learners with special needs.
 - e) Put up signage for evacuation routes and safe places to gather and/or evacuate.
 - f) Ensure that everyone knows what to do during or after an earthquake.
 - g) Ensure family reunification protocol in the school.
 - h) Conduct post evaluation of the drill using the attached form.
5. Proper documentation and the conduct of the Post Activity Evaluation are encouraged. **Reports of the Drill conducted (using NSED Report Template)** will be submitted by respective schools to Schools Division Office through the SGOD-DRRM (c/o Ms. Marjorie S. Rodriguez, PDOII-Division DRRM Coordinator on or before November 6, 2018 , 5 o'clock pm. (Q4 NSED e-template will be provided by the Division ICTO.
6. All shall use the hash tag #SDODagupanQ4NSED2018 #SchoolPatrolPh to all photos/video clips to be posted in the social media.
7. For immediate dissemination and strict compliance.

The objectives are as follows:

1. To evaluate the readiness and awareness of learners and DepEd personnel for earthquakes; and,
2. To evaluate the coordination and communication mechanisms during evacuation procedures and response.

Proper documentation and post-activity evaluation of said drill are required. All field offices are advised to make necessary preparations to ensure that the required reports are submitted on time (Annex A).

SUBJECT : CONDUCT OF THE CY 2018 4th QUARTER NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL (NSED) AND OBSERVANCE OF WORLD TSUNAMI AWARENESS DAY

Rule 6, Section 7 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the RA 10121 states that "Public awareness shall also be undertaken through the conduct of drills by the LDRRMO on a regular basis". Likewise, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) states that one of the activities to achieve Outcome 10: "Developed and implemented comprehensive national and local preparedness and response policies, plans and systems" is to develop/ enhance and simulate scenario-based preparedness and response plans. Furthermore, one of the policy framework stated in the National Disaster Preparedness Plan as embedded in the fourth priority area of the Sendai Framework for Action 2015 – 2030 includes the target: "to promote regular disaster preparedness, response and recovery exercises".

The United Nations General Assembly through Resolution 70/203 called for the participation of its member states "to observe World Tsunami Awareness Day in an appropriate manner and in accordance with national priorities to raise public awareness of the risk caused by tsunamis"

In view hereof, the CY 2018 4th Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) and Observance of World Tsunami Awareness Day is scheduled on **05 November 2018, 8:00 AM**. The National Ceremonial Venue will be at Pagadian City, Zamboanga Del Sur.

The objectives are as follows:

1. The 2018 World Tsunami Awareness Day will focus on Target (c) of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030 which aims at reducing disaster-related economic losses in relation to global Gross Domestic Product by 2030.
2. To increase community awareness and knowledge on tsunami risks through the conduct of "Tsunami Run" for coastal areas.
3. To institutionalize preparedness measures in urban and/or coastal areas.
4. To establish Tsunami Early Warning Systems.

Annex A. Submission Guidelines for the Memorandum on the Conduct of the 2018 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills (CY 2018 Quarterly NSED)

All schools, school division offices, and regional offices should thoroughly follow the guidelines below; non-compliance is tantamount to non-acceptance of said reports:

1. School DRRM Coordinators will submit the reports only to respective SDO DRRM Coordinators by 7 November 2018.
2. Division DRRM Coordinators will consolidate NSED reports from School DRRM Coordinators and will submit only to respective Regional DRRM Coordinators by 14 November 2018.

Division DRRM Coordinators will copy furnish to respective Office of the Schools Division Superintendent.

3. Regional DRRM Coordinators will consolidate NSED reports from Division DRRM Coordinators and will submit to the DRRMS. Submit all consolidated reports regarding the documentation and analysis of the Quarterly NSED to drmm@NSED@deped.gov.ph by 23 November 2018.

Regional DRRM Coordinators should copy furnish to their respective Regional Directors.

4. Cut off time for all deadlines will be at 5:00 PM.
5. Regional DRRM Coordinators should use the naming convention below for emails:

[CY 2018 Q4 NSED] Report_<Region>

For strict compliance.


5. To test the efficiency and usefulness of the preparedness, response and recovery plans, systems and policies developed in their respective localities/ offices/ schools;
6. To evaluate the effectiveness of contingency plan;
7. To test the coordination and communication mechanism during response operation;
8. To understand the command and control mechanism in emergency and disaster operation at the DRRMCs.

All NDRRMC member agencies and OCD Regional Offices are directed to spearhead the conduct of earthquake drill and observance of the World Tsunami Awareness Day in their areas of jurisdiction.

Proper documentation and the conduct of the Post Implementation Evaluation is encouraged. Result of the analysis and documentation should be submitted to the Capacity Building and Training Service through electronic mail at cbts@ocd.gov.ph not later than 15 days after the activity for consolidation and submission to the Chairperson, NDRRMC.
