Government Efforts on Preventive Drug Education Program

- 1. To continuously intensify the existing efforts to provide learners with safe, nurturing, and drug-free environment, the Department of Education (DepEd) issued its Preventive Drug Education Program (PDEP) Policy for Curriculum and Instruction through DepEd Order (DO) No. 30 dated July 12, 2018. The enhanced policy puts a premium on the creation of curricular platforms that shall ensure the integration of essential messages across all learning areas, and strengthen key competencies in the K to 12 Basic Education Program. It was also anchored on earlier issuance including DepEd Memorandum No. 200, s. 2016 (Strengthening the National Drug Education Program in Schools); DO No. 37, s. 2017 (Department of Education Drug-Free Workplace Policy); and DO No. 40, s. 2017 (Guidelines for the Conduct of Random Drug Testing for Public and Private Secondary Schools).
- In this regard, the SDO will conduct a training on the updates of the government efforts on NDEP which will be held on October 15, 2018 @ 1:30 PM - 5:0'clock in the afternoon and October 16, 2018 @ 8:00 - 5:0'clock in the afternoon at the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) office.
