1. In compliance with the provision of DM 223 s. 2016 "Strengthening the implementation of the Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP) in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools Nationwide, this Office shall conduct a Division Search for outstanding Gulayan sa Paaralan Program Implementation from October to December 2018.
2. The objective of this activity are to, motivate, recognize, and reward outstanding performance and dedicated GPP implementation.
3. The Schools Division Search Committee shall evaluate the GPP implementing schools and shall choose one (1) School for GPP Best Implementer to represent the division.
4. The SDS shall nominate one (1) entry school to the Regional Director attached the Division Level Evaluation Sheet and school documentation of their implementation.

Deadline for the submission of Division Entries will be on October 22, 2018.



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
6. The Best School Implementer of GPP will be recognized and awarded on December 2018 based on the following criteria.

Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP)

1. Crop Integration –20%
 - Refers to productive fruits, vegetables, root indigenous plant materials or Indigenous herbal plants.
2. Crop Production System – 25%
 - Use of container vegetables artistry, gardening production and management.
3. Product Utilization – 20%
 - % nutritional problematic school children supported maintained under the Gulayan sa Paaralan program.
4. Sustainability – 15%
 - Presence of sustainability plan (document), nurseries and stakeholders.
5. Land Resource Space Utilization – 10%
 - % utilization of school area suitable for gardening
6. PLUS, FACTOR – 10%
 - Use of edible landscape
7. Awards and Prizes:

The Top 3 Division Winners will receive a Cash Prize and Certificates, Certificate of Recognition will be distributed to all the participating schools to be awarded during the Division Awarding in December with the following prizes. (Prizes will be used for the improvement of the GPP implementations).
