

Delegates' heads, however, are advised to send a written certification from the school head containing the names, grade level, and the contest of the participating students at subolsociety.up@gmail.com on or before DECEMBER 10, 2018. Those who were not able to send a certification are allowed to submit it on the day of the event.
- Confirmation of participation is highly encouraged in order to secure slots in the contests. Interested schools must indicate which contests they will join so that the organizers will predict the logistic needs of each contest beforehand.
- 3. Walk-in participants are highly discouraged because they will be given a less priority status in terms of available facilities and supplies (i.e. tables and chairs for the quiz show, cartolina for poster making, and the like). In addition, walk-in participants are no longer allowed to join the FOLK DANCE COMPETITION.
- 4. Upon the registration, the coaches or the accompanying teachers should provide a complete printed list of their participants with the contest of the students including the name of their school and coaches for a more convenient flow of registration.
 - a. Only ONE (1) coach will be recognized per contest.
 - b. Only ONE (1) certificate (i.e. certificate for participation) will be given to the coach recognized per contest.
- The participating students should bring their current and valid school LD. for verification purposes.

GROUP INTER-CAMPUS QUIZSHOW 23.0 [CODE: EIQ]

1. Participating schools should only have one group for an entry.

The group must be composed of four members (three grade 6 pupils and one grade 5 pupil).

3. Violation of any of the aforementioned mechanics of this competition is subject to

automatic disqualification from the competition.

 Questions will be taken from these areas: Mathematics, Science, History and Geography, Civics and Culture, English and Literature, General Information, Current Events, and Pangasinan Trivia – literature.

c. Current Events questions will be based from events that transpired from

January 2018 to December 2018.

Participating schools are not required to prepare questions as ALL questions will be prepared by the organization.

- 6. The use of electronic gadgets such as music players, calculators, tablets and mobile phones during the contest is strictly prohibited and can be ground for the group's disqualification.
- There are three difficulty rounds in this quiz show: the EASY round worth 10 points, AVERAGE round worth 15 points, and DIFFICULT round worth 20 points.

In addition, wrong spelling of answer is wrong but alternate spellings are accepted provided they have reliable and credible sources and evidence.

- Contestants are strongly advised to get familiarized with current events and issues in the country.
- 4. English will be used as the medium. Essays must be at least two hundred (200) words (articles such as "a", "an" and "the" do not count as words). Entries that fail to meet the minimum word count will automatically be disqualified.
- The theme will be given on the contest proper.
- 6. Contestants shall be given three (3) hours to write their essays.
- Writing sheets will be provided. Participants must bring and use black-inked pen in writing their entries.
- Any form of cheating, plagiarism, falsification of document is considered academic dishonesty and a grave violation. Any transgression against academic honesty, especially plagiarism, will automatically lead to disqualification.
- The contestant may not after his or her entry once it has been submitted to the facilitator of the contest.

- Contestants are strongly advised to get familiarized with current events and issues in the country.
- 4. Filipino will be used as the medium. Essays must be at least two hundred (200) words (articles such as 'ang', 'mga' and 'ng' do not count as words). Entries that fail to meet the minimum word count will automatically be disqualified.
- The theme will be given on the contest proper.
- 6. Contestants shall be given three (3) hours to write their essays.
- Writing sheets will be provided. Participants must bring and use black-inked pen in writing their entries.
- 8. Any form of cheating, plagiarism, falsification of document is considered academic dishonesty and a grave violation. Any transgression against academic honesty, especially plagiarism, will automatically lead to disqualification.

The posters shall be done on a one-fourth sized cartolina paper to be provided by the proctors. ONLY OIL PASTELS are allowed to be used as coloring materials and the participants may use pencil for the initial sketch of the poster. There is no prescribed maximum or minimum number of shades to be used.

3. Violation of any of the aforementioned mechanics of this competition is subject to automatic disqualification from the competition.

4. The theme will be given on the contest day.

5. Contestants shall be given two (2) hours to finish their piece.

6. Participants shall bring and use their own coloring materials. **Borrowing of materials** from their co-contestants is strictly prohibited.

7. The contestant may not after his or her entry once it has been submitted to the facilitator of the contest.

The numbering system of the entries will depend on the order in which they were submitted.

 Parents, coaches, faculty and advisers are prohibited to go near the contest area once the contest proper has started.

10. All entries will be treated through blind judging, meaning the identity of the artist shall be held anonymous by the proctors during the judging process.

 The contestants should render their own interpretation of the piece given by the UP Subol Society. Say Bilay Telek-a-telek by Leonarda "Amor Cico" Carrera will be the piece used by all contestants

All contestants will be assigned with contest numbers through drawing of lots.

- Contestants shall recite and interpret the memorized poem live onstage. A microphone/lapel mic shall/shall not be provided by the event organizers.
- 6. Contestants are allowed to wear any semi-formal attire. Shorts and school uniforms are NOT ALLOWED. Failure to meet the said guideline means 10% deduction from the contestant's total score.
- Contestants are NOT ALLOWED to bring and use props while performing. Music, lighting design and background accompaniment are likewise prohibited. Violation of this guideline means 10% deduction from the contestant's total score.
- 8. Actual delivery of the poem shall not exceed five (5) minutes. Failure to comply with the given requirement renders the contestant a score deduction of one point or a fraction thereof per 10 seconds of extension. Timer will start once the contestant already said his/her first word.

. In order to guide the speakers, time cards of the remaining minutes shall be flashed

at certain parts of the performance.

- Each participant shall render his or her own choice of song written in Pangasinan.
 The songs may not be limited to the following: Insyong, Agac la Manesia, Dalem na Dayat, Inar-aro Taka, Bituen tan Dua, and Liwaway Bulan.
 - a. Due to the common use of the song, contestants are restricted from singing Malinac Lay Labi and will demerit 10 points if so. Contestants are encouraged to opt for other Pangasinan songs.
- 4. Songs that are originally written in other languages and are merely translated to Pangasinan shall not be allowed and will result to 10-point deduction.
- 5. All participants will be assigned with contest numbers through drawing of lots on the day of the contest.
- 6. Participants are allowed to wear any semi-formal attire. Shorts and school uniforms are NOT allowed. A 10-point deduction from the total score will be merited to the participant/s who will not meet this guideline.
- Actual song shall not exceed five (5) minutes. A 5-point deduction from the total score will be merited to the participant/s that will exceed to the allowed competing time.

- 1. Participating schools should only have one group per entry.
- 2. The group must be composed of four (4) to six (6) pairs of pupils from grades 4 to 6.
- Violation of any of the aforementioned mechanics of this competition is subject to automatic disqualification from the competition.
- To maximize accommodation, only those schools that confirmed their participation in this contest on or before DECEMBER 10, 2018 will be admitted on the contest day.
 Walk-in groups shall NOT be given slots.
 - Each group will be assigned with contest numbers through drawing of lots on the day of the contest.
- Participating groups must perform/interpret a Pangasinan skilled folk dance, with their own choice of Filipino folk music. The folk dance may not be limited to the following: Sayaw ed Tapew na Bangko, Binasuan, Binislakan, and Oasioas.
- 6. Participating groups must also submit a short-description of the folk dance chosen at subalsociety.up@gmail.com. Groups may submit only until the 10th minute prior the start of the said competition. A 3-point deduction from the total score will be merited to a group/s that will fail to do so.
- The actual presentation is strictly minimum of four (4) minutes and maximum of six
 (6) minutes which includes the entrance and exit of the participants and props.
- 8. The time starts on the first move to be made by the participants as part of their presentation IF THERE ARE NO props to be entered in the performing area OR on the first props to be entered in the performing area by the coach/es.
- A 5-point deduction from the total score will be merited to a group/s that will exceed to the allowed competing time.

- 13. The music piece must be burned in an audio CD only which will be submitted upon the registration. Prepare a back-up for untoward cases of hardware multination.
- 14. When a participant is injured, the injured participant should stop performing so that the organizers will give him or her proper treatment about the injury he or she acquired.
