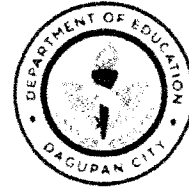
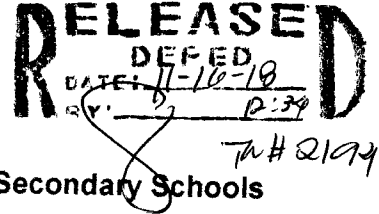

**DAGUPAN CITY ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION MEET 2018
HIP-HOP DANCE COMPETITION**

Guidelines:

1. Each group shall have a minimum of eight (8) and maximum of ten (10) members.
2. Performance should not exceed three (3) minutes. One (1) point shall be deducted for every five (5) seconds exceeding the limit. Timing of performance will start from the first note of the music and ends at the last note of the music (including entrance and exit).
3. Attire/costume must be decent.
4. Dangerous routines (stunts, tumbling, throwing, body dropping, etc.) are not allowed to avoid any untoward accidents or injuries, and shall be ground for disqualification.
5. Use of props is prohibited.
6. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

CRITERIA	PERCENTAGE
CHOREOGRAPHY (Dance arrangements, concept, entertainment value/crowd appeal, staging, spacing formations and level/changes, synchronization)	40%
ORIGINALITY (Incorporating unique and original / creative moves)	25%
THEME AND MUSIC (Musicality, beat techniques, timing, moves related to music)	20%
COSTUME	15%
TOTAL	100%
