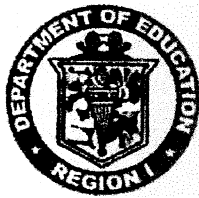

Subject: **Continuous Improvement (CI) Training-Workshop**

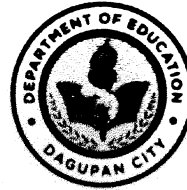


