To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. This Office through the Education Support Services Division, will conduct the Teacher-Adviser Training Program (TATP) Regional Mass Training of Teachers on December 17-19, 2018. Specific venue will be announced in a separate issuance.
 - 2. The training program specifically aims to:

 - d. deepen the understanding of teacher-advisers on the learner's interests, motivation, and the importance of youth participation in their holistic development; and
 - e. increase the support and contribution in the student organization as teacher-adviser
