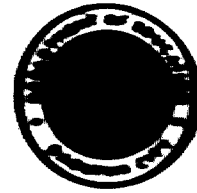

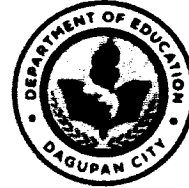
1. All school heads are reminded to submit the PHIL-IRI Results English (Post) including the names of non-readers on or before April 5.
2. This office commends school heads who have already submitted the said results including other related data (alphabet name/sound knowledge, conduct of English Programs/Projects/Activities and quarter exam data/least learned skills). Please see attachments.
3. Likewise, all school heads are enjoined to further strengthen the implementation of school-based reading program.

The following intervention schemes are strongly suggested for school year 2019-2020.

- The school-based seminar/s in beginning reading (phonics method, the whole word approach and language experience method) for parents/guardians/siblings of non-readers shall be conducted as soon as possible and as often as needed.
- Parents shall be informed of the "No read, no move policy" of the school during Brigada Eskwela.
- School-based summer classes for non-readers shall be conducted with the approval of parents, availability and willingness of concerned teachers/school heads.
 - The conduct of reading assessment/inventory of learners shall be scheduled during Brigada Eskwela instead of June or July.
 - The conduct of reading classes shall start by June instead of July.



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- Energetic teachers with Early Childhood Development degrees shall be assigned to teach Grades 1-3 learners.
- Homogeneous grouping instead of heterogenous shall be implemented for Grades 1-3. Said learners shall be grouped according to their alphabet name and sound knowledge.
- Grades 4-6 and junior high school non-readers shall be confined only to learning of alphabet names and sounds during English class from June to July.
- All learners shall fill out a Daily Learning Log to validate their understanding of the lessons. Such outputs will be used as reference to improve English instruction.

Aside from English notebook, all learners shall have a separate notebook for new words learned daily. The use of recycled papers as vocabulary notebook is strongly encouraged.

- Dictation exercises shall be included in the daily routine of the learners as advised by Dr. Cresilda Ochang, Regional Supervisor- English.
- Principal/PSDS/EPS shall conduct monthly or quarterly reading test to validate reading assessment/inventory of learners.
- 4. Accomplishment Report in English is expected to be submitted to EPS Agnes Bacugan as soon as possible.

Monthly or quarterly audit of learned competencies in English is also expected to start this school year.

- 5. Your cooperation is highly appreciated. Our ultimate mission is to nurture independent readers who love reading.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.




