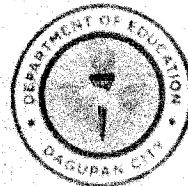

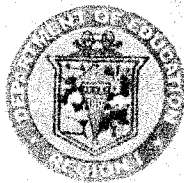

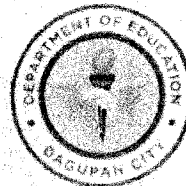

1. In view of the **OUA Memorandum No. 12-0519-0178, and DepEd Order No. 48, s. 2012**, stipulating that all public and private schools, and DepEd offices and attached agencies are encouraged to undertake the Quarterly Conduct of the National School-Based Earthquake and Fire Drills, and in relation to the recent Magnitude 6.1 Earthquake in Castillejos, Zambales and Magnitude 6.5 Earthquake in San Julian, Eastern Samar as well as the series of shaking in other parts of the country, we are enjoining offices across all level to participate in the conduct of the **2nd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills (NSED) on June 20, 2019 at 02:00PM.**
 2. Objectives of the Quarterly NSED are as follows: a. To evaluate the readiness and awareness of learners and DepEd personnel for earthquakes; and b. To evaluate the Coordination and communication mechanism during evacuation procedures and response. This is a Co-Curricular activity
 3. SDO Dagupan shall likewise ensure the conduct of the said event, and shall be participated by all Division personnel who are not included in the monitoring team. The following shall be the the **Division NSED facilitators** for this quarter:
 - a) **NSED Quarter 2, 2019 - SGOD** (Team leader: Chief, SGOD with the Emergency Medical and Dental Health Services)
- This shall form part of the capacity building of all Division Personnel in terms of preparedness in times of Disaster. Post-Evaluator shall be from our DRRM Partner agencies.
4. In addition, Division Monitoring Officials shall be deployed to validate and post-evaluate the School NSED. (Final List of Division Monitoring Team and schedule of orientation to be announced).
 5. All schools are encouraged to invite our DRRM Partner agencies, BDRRM Council and other DRRM partner Stakeholders/agencies to help during the Post-Evaluation Activity.
 6. **All Public Schools District Supervisors and School Heads are advised to ensure that all schools are to comply with the conduct of the said activity, with Post-Evaluation and proper documentation.**

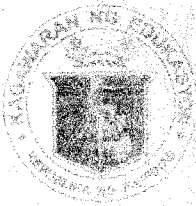

8. The participants checked for any sustained injury in the evacuation/assembly area/s.						
9. A headcount was conducted while in the evacuation area.

12. The First Aid/Medical Team immediately addressed all medical needs of the injured victims and casualties.

15. The Evacuation Team properly executed the evacuation procedures.						
16. The Site Security Team adequately secured the perimeter for the drill area.						
17. The Maintenance Team observed protocols in ensuring the building safety before re-entering.						
18. The Communication utilized the equipment properly during the coordination and execution of response operations.						
19. The Transportation team ensured the availability of vehicles.
