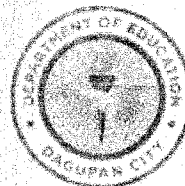

**SUBJECT :** REITERATING THE CONDUCT OF STUDENT-LED SCHOOL  
WATCHING AND HAZARD MAPPING 2019

**DATE :** June 07, 2019

1. This is to reiterate to all public elementary and secondary schools the conduct of the **"Student-led School Watching and Hazard Mapping"** every first month (June) of every school year as stipulated in DO 23, s. 2015 (Student-led School Watching and Hazard Mapping) and DM 101 s. 2016.
2. The student-led school watching and hazard mapping are initial steps in engaging learners in disaster preparedness and management. This activity will raise awareness and equip learners with information and skills necessary to address the impact of hazards. Through this activity, the Department of Education (DepEd) creates an opportunity for learners to understand their role in disaster risk reduction and management (DRRM).
3. The following are the main objectives of the activity: a) Improve students' level of awareness on the potential hazards and risks within and around schools; b) Increase the participation of children in addressing potential disasters by reducing vulnerabilities; and c) Inculcate a culture of safety in the day-to-day experience of children in school.
4. This activity shall be conducted by all public elementary and secondary schools. For details and guidelines, please download **DO23 s. 2015**.
5. All Schools shall inform the Division through the DRRM of their respective schedule of the event. The Division shall ensure monitoring of the activity through the DRRM & YFD and concerned PSDS.
6. Proper documentation and prompt reporting of the said activity is required, duly signed by school heads, with the following details:
  - a. School ID
  - b. School Name
  - c. Date of Orientation and School Watching and Hazard Mapping Activity
  - d. Date of Presentation to the School Planning Team (SPT)/PTA
  - e. Identified Concerns during implementation:
  - f. Please attach the following:
    - One Page Photo Documentation - School Watching Route Plan
    - School Watching Team - Summary of the Risk Factors Observed/Identified
    - Attendance Sheet - School Watching Route Plan
    - Hazard Map (based on SWT discussion and duly approved by the School Head)

In this regard, the Division shall send the link to be used for the uploading of the reports in the DRRM Official InfoChat. **Schools are requested to submit the reports on/or before June 27, 2019.**

**The Division shall consolidate the results of the "Student-led School Watching and Hazard Mapping and shall submit the reports to the DRRMS Central Office at the end of the month.**
