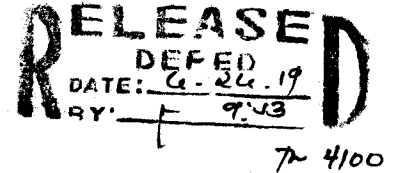



SUBJECT : REITERATING THE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS MEASURES  
FOR SCHOOLS AND PREPAREDNESS MEASURES FOR  
RAINY SEASON

DATE : June 25, 2019



1. The Schools Division Office of Dagupan reiterates the "**Disaster Preparedness Measures for Schools**", as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 83, s. 2011 and DM 108, s. 2016 entitled "**Preparedness Measures for the Rainy Season**".
2. All schools are hereby directed to strengthen established mechanisms to safeguard and protect all our learners and personnel from death, injury and harm in schools during any calamities/natural disasters.
3. In view of this, schools are directed to implement mitigation measures as for natural disasters (e.g. typhoons, floods) among others:
  - a. Ensure that learning materials, text books, teaching manuals, school records and school equipment (DCP, laptop, photo copier, et al) at a safe place, preferably on elevated room to ensure protection from rain or flood.
  - b. Ensure learners and personnel are educated on preparedness measures.
  - c. Stay alert and Be updated on weather advisories at all times.
  - d. Conduct regular multi-hazard drills or simulations in close coordination and collaboration with experts/partners;
  - e. Ensure proper emergency exit signages and compliance with fire safety inspection results;
4. In addition, all schools shall ensure learning continuity (in case of suspension or cancellation of classes due to typhoons/or Habagat through) through prepared teacher made modules which will help our learners to cope with their studies.
5. Moreover, schools are encouraged to invoke to learners, personnel and community partners that "**Safety is everyone's responsibility**".
