- b. Presentations may also be in the form of workshop or demonstration of innovative culture-based lessons and instructional materials provided that they are supported by strong empirical evidence.
- c. Abstracts may be written in Filipino or English.
- d. Notice of acceptance of abstracts will be released on August 30, 2019.
- e. Full papers of accepted abstracts must be received by the Conference Secretariat no later than August September 6, 2019.
