BANDA KONTRA DROGA (BATTLE OF THE BAND) and

SHORT FILMMAKING CONTEST

To continuously intensify its existing efforts to provide Filipino learners with safe, nurturing, and drug-free environment, the Department of Education (DepEd) issued its Preventive Drug Education Program (PDEP) through DepEd Order (DO) No. 30 dated July 12, 2018. The enhanced policy puts a premium on the creation of curricular platforms that shall ensure the integration of essential messages across all learning areas, and strengthen key competencies in the K to 12 Basic Education Program. This is also provided in earlier issuances including DepEd Memorandum No. 200, s. 2016 (Strengthening the National Drug Education Program in Schools).

In this regard, the public elementary and secondary schools in Dagupan City have established Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD), a peer-based program designed as a preventive education and information tool to counter the dangers and disastrous effects of drug abuse. It aims to empower the individual to be the catalyst within his peer groups in advocating healthy and drug-free lifestyles through involvement in various wholesome activities.

Towards this end, DepEd Dagupan City will be conducting "BANDA KONTRA DROGA" (Battle of the Band) competition and SHORT FILMMAKING CONTEST to support the government's Drug Education Program.

1. The Battle of the Band is open to all teachers and secondary students from different institutional districts.

- 2. The participating band shall be composed of a minimum 5 members and a maximum of 10 members.
- 3. Band members are required to bring their own instruments.
- 4. Band members are responsible for the security of their equipment and the event organizer cannot be held liable for any lost, damaged or stolen equipment..
- 5. The entire performance must be live. No fully-programmed music is permitted.
- 6. Draw lots will be done at least thirty minutes before 3:00 PM in the afternoon the event to determine the order of performance. If a band or band member is not around when the band is due for presentation, the band will be disqualified. The next band will take their slot.
- 7. The participating band shall perform two (2) songs (1) warm-up song (any OPM song) (1) Song composition about drug education as contest piece. The songs to be performed shall have a minimum duration of 5 minutes and a maximum of 7 minutes.
- 8. There shall be no required genre of music for the contest piece.
- 9. No age limit is required among participants.
- 10. Only those who have submitted their entries on the date of established deadline, September 30,2019, and those present during the draw lots shall be considered as official contestants.
- 11. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

1. Deadline for submission/confirmation of duly accomplished entry form and three (3) copies of original contest piece (Font:Times Roman, 12) shall be on September 30, 2019, until 5:00PM.

Editing	5%
