- 1. Please be informed of the attached DepEd Memorandum (OUA Memo 12-0819-0292), entitled "Provision of Psychological First Aid for all Learners and Personnel Affected by Violent Armed Conflicts.
- For each incident, Division DRRM Coordinators shall lead the assessment, planning, implementation and monitoring of PFA activities tailor fitted for needs and profile of target learners and personnel. This shall include deployment of Trained PFA providers, and if needed, referral pathways for learners and personnel identified for further specialized psychological support services.
- In addition, the Division reiterates that all public schools should make the necessary review and enhancement of their respective, preparedness measures, School DRRM-CCA Plan as well as School Contingency Plan.
- 4. This is to reiterate further the usage of the <u>RADAR 1 & 2 templates</u> as stipulated in DO21,s. 2015—for Large Scale Hazards ((Tropical Cyclones, Earthquakes, etc.), while School Incident Report template shall be used for <u>Small Scale Hazards</u> affecting only the school (please see attached form hereto).
- 5. As DepEd response intervention, SDOs are directed to facilitate the provision of appropriate Psychological First Aid (PFAs) interventions to affected learners and personnel following all incidents of violent incidents and armed conflict affecting schools and must be conducted before the resumption of classes.

INCIDENTS AND ARMED CONFLICT

In light of recent incidents of armed violence, and the mandate of the partment of Education to protect and promote learner welfare and the right to slity education at all times, Schools Division Offices are directed to facilitate provision of appropriate Psychological First Aid (PFA) interventions to ected learners and personnel following all incidents of violent incidents l armed conflict affecting schools.

As facilitating the return to normalcy requires addressing the immediate eds of affected learners and personnel in the aftermath of critical incidents, PFA st be conducted before the resumption of regular classes.

For each incident, Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (RM) Coordinators shall lead the assessment, planning, implementation, and nitoring of PFA activities tailor-fitted for the needs and profile of the target mers and personnel. This shall include deployment of trained PFA providers, i if needed, referral pathways for learners and personnel identified for further cialized psychological support services.

Funds and other support needed for this purpose may be requested by the nools Division Superintendent from the Disaster Risk Reduction and nagement Service.
