Regional Memorandum No. 213 S. 2019 embodies the guidelines on revitalizing scouting in schools nationwide and the SDO Dagupan City recognizes the role of scouting in molding learners into responsible and responsive citizens.

In support of scouting and Happy Schools Movement (HSM), this Office encourages the:

- 1. Integration of scouting in the curriculum.
- Conduct of school-based scouting activities in every school and wearing of neckerchiefs in all scouting activities.
- 3. Carry out one-day school-based camp to coincide with the Girl Scout Week. Integrate any of the suggested activities attached to this memo.
- 4. Discourage Popularity Contests in scouting activities.
- 5. Promote membership in all schools.

As such, the popularity contest used to be held yearly under the program "Environmental Rally" will not be held this year. Instead, these activities may be integrated in the camping activities focusing on the talent and personality of girl scouts.

All schools therefore are encouraged to intensify and strengthen their membership registration per **DepEd Regional Memorandum No 213 S. 2019**, making **every girl a Girl Scout and every female teacher a troop leader.** The Membership Status of each school shall be strongly monitored.

To discuss other details pertaining the said events, the Council Trainers, District Field Advisers and JHS and SHS Coordinators are advised to attend a meeting **on Friday, September 27, 2019 @ 3:00 pm** at the Council Headquarters, Dagupan City.

GUIDELINES ON REVITALIEING SCOUTING IN SCHOOLS REGIONWIDE

- To Schools Division Superintendents
 Chief Education Supervisors School Governance and
 Operations Division (SGOD)
 School Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools
- 1. Scouting is an effective co-curricular program in the leadership and value formation of every learner. Its objective is consistent with the Department of Education's mission to develop every learner into well-rounded individual with exemplary character.
- 2. This Office recognizes the significant role of scouting in molding learners into responsible and responsive citizens of the country and in contributing to the efforts of achieving quality education. As a co-curricular program, scouting helps stem away vices and bad influence of drugs and peers. As such, participation of every learner in scouting program, activities and projects should be highly encouraged and supported in the schools.
- 3. In support of the Happy Schools Movement (HSM), this Office encourages the revitalization of Scouting Program in schools region wide in various areas of possible partnership and cooperation consistent with the following guidelines:
 - 3.1 Make every teacher a scout leader. Forge partnership with the Boy and Girl Scout Councils for the conduct of trainings, and reduce or cut training fees.
 - 3.2 Integrate scouting in the curriculum and homeroom sessions. Conduct life skills, livelihood and basic life support trainings after school hours.
 - 3.3 Promote and conduct school based scouting activities in every school. Make every Friday a scouting day and encourage the wearing of neckerchiefs in all scouting activities.
 - 3.4 Carry-out a one-day school based camp. Discourage, however, the usage of and bringing of gadgets, i.e., gas stove, dispenser, refrigerator and the like. Discourage catering of meals during outdoor camp/jamborees.

- 3.5 Discourage popularity contests in scouting activities.
- 3.6 Involve or immerse scouts in relevant community services. Community service involvement teaches learners compassion and understanding.
- 3.7 Promote membership in all schools.
- 4. The following DepEd issuance on Boy or Girl Scouting is reiterated:
 - 4.1 DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012 Revitalizing Boy Scouting in Schools Nationwide; and
 - 4.2 DepEd Order No. 86, s. 2012 Revitalizing Girl Scouting in Schools Nationwide
- 5. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
