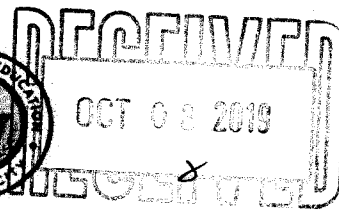
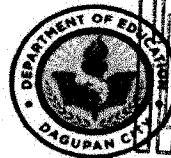

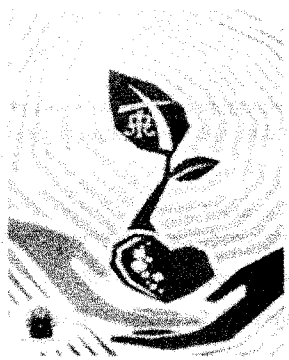

Date: **October 2, 2019**

On October 22, 1978, the very day of the inauguration of his papal ministry, at the conclusion of the liturgy, Pope John Paul II said to the young people gathered in St. Peter's Square: **"You are the hope of the Church and of the world. You are my hope."** He had often repeated these words.

Later in his book, the "Threshold of Hope", St. John Paul II asked: *Is there really hope in the young?*

In his first World Youth Day appearance, Pope Francis asked the youth gathered during the Opening Mass several times: "Can we change things?" and the youth shouted: "Yes!" In his Open Letter to the Youth before the Synod of Bishops, the Holy Father wrote: "Do not tolerate injustice and not bow to a "throw-away culture" nor give in to the globalization of indifference. Listen to the cry arising from your inner selves! Even when you feel, like the prophet Jeremiah, the inexperience of youth, God encourages you to go where He sends you: "Do not be afraid, [...], because I am with you to deliver you" (Jer 1:8). A better world can be built also as a result of your efforts, your desire to change and your generosity. Do not be afraid to listen to the Spirit who proposes bold choices; do not delay when your conscience asks you to take risks in following the Master. The Church also wishes to listen to your voice, your sensitivities and your faith; even your doubts and your criticism. Make your voice heard, let it resonate in communities and let it be heard by your shepherds of souls. St. Benedict urged the abbots to consult, even the young, before any important decision, because "the Lord often reveals to the younger what is best."

The youth of Pangasinan have so much to give and to share. Caught up in their own varied interests, however, they are not always aware of what they can do – for themselves, for their families, for their fellow young, for the communities they belong to and to the society as a whole. At times, they tend to ignore the signs that tell them to do their share in making this part of the world a better place to live in.

Underlining these realities about the Pangasinan Youth, the Archdiocese of Lingayen Dagupan continues to reach out to and accompany the young Pangasinanenses – whenever, where ever and how ever they may be - continuously imbibing St. John Paul II's ardor of always putting hope in the young and drawing inspiration from the challenge of Pope Francis to make Christ Fully alive in the young.

Hence, as the entire Philippine Church celebrates this 2019, the Year of the Filipino Youth as part of the nine-year preparation for the 500th Anniversary of Christianity in the Philippines, the Archdiocese of Lingayen-Dagupan through its Ministry of Social Action, in coordination with the Archdiocesan Youth and Campus Ministries and in collaboration with a number of student-welfare advocates in the academe, stages ILALO, a Student-Leaders' Summit.

ILALO is the Pangasinan word for HOPE.

The ILALO VISION

Generally, ILALO, the Student-Leaders' Summit, sees the Pangasinense Student-Leader as the greatest resource to move our nation toward true democracy – socially, politically, economically and ecologically. It envisions empowered Christian Student Leaders in Pangasinan who are willing to share their giftedness by being advocates and witnesses of Christian values and teachings to their fellow youth-students.

The ILALO MISSION

ILALO shall be a gathering of different student Leaders from the different schools in Pangasinan, educating them about the Moral Social Teachings and molding them as advocates of these teachings.

Anchored on the Year of the Youth Theme, i.e, Filipino Youth in Mission: Beloved, Gifted Empowered, ILALO 2019, specifically, aims to make the participating Student-Leaders:

1. **BELOVED.** To make them feel that the Church is always there to serve as their Mother and Guide especially in their exercise of leadership, having Jesus as their example.
2. **GIFTED.** To let them see and share their giftedness in the spirit of Stewardship (Panabangan).
3. **EMPOWERED.** To challenge and mobilize them to be advocates of Moral Social Teachings in their own schools and communities.

FRAMEWORK of ILALO 2019

Financial Counterpart

Since the ILALO 2019 Organizing Committee operates with very minimal funds, each participant is requested to pay the Registration Fee which shall cover:

- ✓ Participant's Kit
- ✓ Participant's ILALO 2019 Souvenir T-Shirt
- ✓ Participant's Food and Accommodation during the Summit

The Graduated Registration Fees per participant are as follows:

- Participants from Senior High Schools - P 700.00 (Public and private)
- Participants from Catholic Schools - P800.00.00
- Participants from Colleges and Universities - P1,000.00

The delegations are advised to keep the total number of Participants that they have reserved and paid for. Deadline for submission of the total Registration Fees is on October 10, 2019.

Registration Procedure and Policies

For a well-organized Student-Leaders' Summit, the following ILALO 2019 Forms must be accomplished by the Delegation Head and Individual Participants:

A. Registration Forms

- **GROUP REGISTRATION FORM W/ SUMMARY OF REGISTRATION**
Delegation Head must accomplish this form and submit it **together with the Participants' Solidarity Fee, not later than October 10, 2019** to the Ilalo 2019 Secretariat, Pastoral Office, Archbishop's House, Jovellanos St., Dagupan City.
- **INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION FORM**
Each participant has to accomplish this Form and submit it to his/her Delegation Head. The accomplished Individual Registration Forms must be submitted together with the Group Registration Form.

B. Cancellation of Delegates/Policy On Refunds

The ILALO 2019 is a self-sustaining event. The organizers cannot absorb the financial burden of cancelled participation and therefore, will not issue refunds. For this reason, if one member of the delegation would not be able to participate in the ILALO II a most possible solution is to replace him/her. Replacement should be of the same gender to that of the participant to be replaced.

C. Additional Slots

Should there be schools which will not be able to fill-up their allotted slots, interested schools may request for additional slots, but on a first-come, first serve basis.

Accommodations

Delegates will be accommodated in foster homes, with 2-3 delegates per foster family, Accommodations will be provided on the evenings of October 20 and 21.

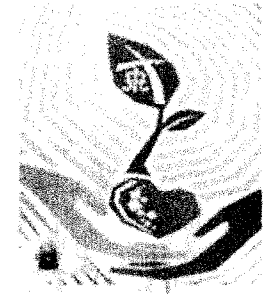
Some Helpful tips to be the Best of Guests

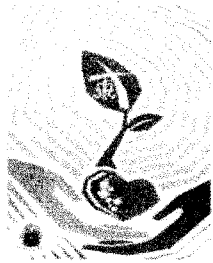

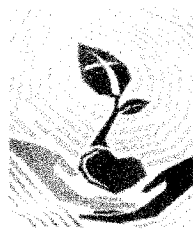
