

#### POSTER MAKING CONTEST

#### Guidelines/Mechanics:

1. The Poster Making Contest is open to interested Grade 5 or 6 Students of public elementary schools of Dagupan City. One contestant per school.

2. The theme for this year's campaign shall be "Oplan: Iwas Paputok, Fireworks Display ang Patok. Makiisa sa Fireworks Display sa Inyong Lugar!".

3. The participants will be provided with illustration board, oil pastels crayons, permanent marker and pencil.

4. The participants must complete their artwork for three hours on December 4, 2019 at 8:00 am (venue/school is TBA).

5. The following are the criteria for Judging:

6. All entries will be judged by Board of Judges composed of representatives from DOH, PIA, DepEd, DILG regional offices.

7. Winners will be identified and announced during the launching program on December 5, 2019 at Dagupan City Astrodome.

8. Ownership of artworks will be transferred to the Department of Health Center for Health Development – I for exhibition during health promotion activities.

#### "2019 IWAS PAPUTOK CAMPAIGN"

#### JINGLE MAKING CONTEST

#### Guidelines/Mechanics:

- 1. The Jingle Making Contest is open to interested group of Junior High School Students of Dagupan City (at least ten members in each group). One group/contestant shall represent per school.
- 2. The content of the Jingle must highlight the following:
  - a. Conduct of Community Fireworks Display to minimize the risk of injuries and casualties
  - b. Role of DepEd in educating the children on the risk of injuries in using firecrackers
  - c. Role of DILG (including LGU, PNP, BFP) in regulating the sale, manufacture and use of firecrackers and other pyrotechnic devices
  - d. Role of DOH in the prevention and control of tetanus and provision of healthy tips or advisory in celebrating Yuletide Season.
  - e. Role of other agencies in promoting healthy environment in celebrating Yuletide Season.
- 3. Lyrics should not contain vulgar and rude words. Violation for this guideline will result to disqualification.
- 4. The participants must provide a 5 (five) copies of lyrics for the judges.
- 5. The participants must perform their jingle in five minutes on December 4, 2019 at 8:00 am (venue/school is TBA).
- 6. The following are the criteria for Judging:

Lyrics-	20%
Originality-	20%
Music/Melody-	20%
Interpretation-	20%
Creativity and Costume-	20%
Total-	100%

- 7. All entries will be judged by Board of Judges composed of representatives from DepEd, PIA and DOH regional offices.
- 8. Winners will be identified and announced during the launching program on December 5, 2019.
- 9. Ownership of jingles will be transferred to the Department of Health Center for Health Development I for exhibition during health promotion activities.
