SUBJECT: DOH-Environmental Health, Global Handwashing and World Toilet Day

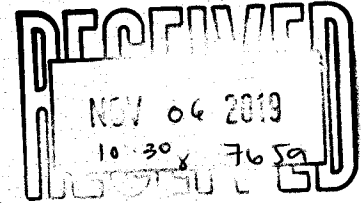
