MECHANICS

1. Three (3) students per entry. Open for Senior High School only.
2. Participants are given 6 hours to finish their Outputs.
3. Student-participants may be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist the student during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition.
4. The participant should execute one solid composition or concept.
5. The participants must bring their own paintbrushes, sponges, paint containers and paint cleaning materials (newspapers, washcloth, etc) while acrylic paint in primary colors (red, blue, yellow) and neutral colors (black & white), easels and canvass (36x48 inches) will be provided by the host.
6. Participants are not allowed to bring pictures or images for reference of their entries.
7. The subject of the painting will be based on a theme which will be given during the event.
8. Participants must come on time thus late contestants will no longer be entertained.

MECHANICS

1. Open to Junior and Senior High School Only. Contestants should be at the contest venue thirty (30) minutes before the competition.
2. The contestants are allowed to use any Digital Camera (point and shoot only) with a maximum of 20.1 megapixels. Contests who will use any DSLR, Mirrorless, smartphones and other high-end cameras will not be permitted to join the contest.
3. The contestant should bring his/her own camera cable, card reader and memory card for uploading and saving of pictures.
4. Cellular phones, extra digital cameras, extra storage card or any additional materials/equipment are not allowed in the con test area.
5. The contestants shall load the empty storage card in front of the contest administrator.
6. Participants will be ask to produce three (3) best photos with caption for the "theme" given to them.
7. Contestants are given one (1) hour to take pictures, which does not include the loading and unloading of the storage card in front of the contest administrator.
8. during the actual photoshoot, the advisers, coaches, trainers and parents are NOT allowed in the venue.
9. Contestants are allowed to take unlimited shots, but only four (4) shots (three best shots and one control shot) will be submitted as official entries.
10. Contestants should submit their three (3) photos that are laid our using MS word and saved as pdf and one control shot. Hence, each contestant shall have five (4) files in their folder – four shots and PDF file.
11. Competition will be on December 11, 2019 9AM – 4PM during the Pangasinan 1st Children Summit at CSI Stadia Lucao District, Dagupan City.

MECHANICS:

- The Poster Making contest is open to secondary students (Public/Private) and must be currently enrolled for school year 2019-2020.
- Contestant shall provide their own oil pastels, brushes and other materials that they need for the contest. The contestant's artwork shall be painted on a landscape ½ illustration board. The illustration board will be provided by the committee.
- The artwork of the contestant must revolve around theme which will be announced during the contest day.
- All artworks must be on-the-spot and must be completed within the allotted time of two (2) hours. Unfinished artwork will be disqualified and will not be included in the judging.
- All entries will be pre-numbered. No signatures, names or other identifying marks should appear at either side of the material of the entry.
- All entries shall be judged by a board of judges composed of experts on the fields of arts. Winning and non-winning entries will become the properties of the organizers.
- Winners will be identified and awarded at the end of the activity

Event Rules and Mechanics

- a. "HIMIG PAMASKO" is a high school show choir competition.
- b. The group should be a composition of the following:
 - 15 members and a maximum of 20 members from

Grade 7 to grade 12 only.
 - One teacher / Coach / Conductor
 - One accompanist if needed
- c. The contestants shall have the following requirement:
 - Certification of enrollment duly signed by the principal or registrar
 - School ID to be presented at the contest proper
- d. The group shall sing 3 Christmas songs
 - Pangasinan
 - Tagalog
 - English
- e. The performance shall last up to 10 minutes with another 2-3 minutes of entrance and exit.
- f. Competition will be on December 11, 2019 3PM – 5PM during the Pangasinan 1st Children Summit at CSI Stadia Lucao District, Dagupan City.

PANGASINAN 1ST CHILDREN SUMMIT
3ON3 BASKETBALL

THE GAME

- All games will have a 15 minutes running clock. Each team will be awarded one (45 second) timeout per game.
- Teams must have a minimum of 3 players to start a game. Game Time is Forfeit Time! Teams may have up to 5 players listed on their roster.
- Rosters may be altered until the close of tournament check in.

ELIGIBILITY

- Everyone **MUST** present his school ID at check in.
- Teams are permitted only one basketball team member or former basketball player per roster. Professional or former professional basketball players are prohibited from all Intramural basketball events.
- Former Intercollegiate basketball player **MUST** have been removed from competition for a period of one full calendar year before they may participate in Intramural Basketball Events. Individuals may only play for one team.

SCORING

- All baskets made inside the 3 point line (take back area) will be scored as 1 point and offense will retain possession.
- Baskets made beyond the 3 point arc will be scored as two points.
- Games will be played to 16 and teams must win by two, however, the first team to reach 21 win be declared the winner.
- Technical fouls to reach and flagrant fouls will be awarded two points to the opposing team.

LIVE BALL/DEAD BALL POSSESSION

- A coin flip will be used to determine which team will begin with the ball at midcourt.
- Games will be played using a "winner's out" or "make it take it" format, in which following a made basket, possession will remain the same.
- Following all made baskets the ball must be checked in at the midcourt line.
- The offensive player must pass the ball into play.
- All fouls and violations will be played out of bounds at the top of the court. Out of bounds ball will be played firm the midcourt line and must be checked in as well.
- Following a missed basket or steal that results in a change of possession the ball must always be taken back beyond the 3 point (take back) line.

- Violations will only be called should the offending team score a basket. Should the violating team score a basket, the point will be removed from the scoreboard and change a possession will take place at midcourt.

SUBSTITUTION

- Player substitution may take place on all dead ball situations, but must be beckoned by the court official.
- Players who enter the playing court without being summonsed by a court official will receive a technical foul.

FOULS AND VIOLATIONS

- All player fouls and violations will be the sole responsibility of the court official. There will be not appeals regarding calls made on the court. Fouls will be recorded throughout each game. Players who accumulate 5 personal fouls will foul out of the contest. Questions of rule interpretation are the only situations in which appeals may be made.

• Team Fouls #14:

- The offensive team will retain possession and the foul will be recorded (basketball not made). Should the offensive team be in the act of shooting and make the basketball, no foul shots will be awarded, the basket will count and the ball will be taken out at the top of the key.

• Team Fouls#59:

- Once a team has committed (#59) team fouls, the foul will be recorded and the opposing team will be awarded a foul shot. Change of possession will occur if the foul shot is missed. Should the shooter make the foul shot they will retain possession at midcourt.

• Team Fouls #10above:

- For all fouls in the double bonus (#10above) the opposing team will be awarded a foul shot and possession of the ball at midcourt regardless if the foul shot is made or missed.

• Technical/Intentional/Flagrant Fouls:

- All incidents of a technical foul, intentional foul or flagrant foul being called will result in two dead ball foul shots awarded to the opposing team.
- The opposing team will also retain possession of the ball at midcourt regardless if the foul shots were made. Flagrant fouls come with and automatic ejection.
- Two technical fouls committed by an individual during a single game will result in that individual being ejected from competition. Any player ejected from an intramural event will be

declared ineligible until they have scheduled a time to speak with the Intramural Sports Director and have been approved to return to competition.

TEAM CAPTAIN'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Keep teammates and fans up to date on all current rule changes and policies.
- Act as the sole voice for you team.
- Keep control of all players and fans.
- Ensuring all teammates are eligible under the George Mason Intramural Rules and Regulations
