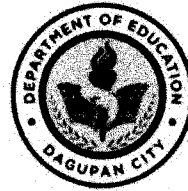

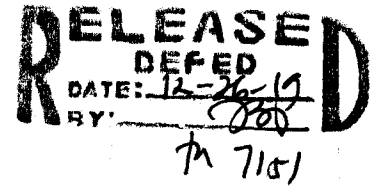

Subject: **TEACHERS TRAINING IN TEACHING STUDENTS WITH VISUAL
IMPAIRMENT**

1. Schools Division Office of Dagupan City, in partnership with Adaptive Technology for Rehabilitation, Integration, and Empowerment of the Visually Impaired (ATRIV) will conduct a **FREE** 5-day teachers training on **January 8 – 12, 2019** from **8:00 am – 5:00 pm** at Dagupan City National High School – Junior High School Audio –Visual Room (AVR).
2. The training aims to:
 - a. orient the participants on inclusive education;
 - b. provide participants with knowledge on how to use computers using built-in screen reader feature; and
 - c. equip teachers with the understanding of the challenges that visually impaired students encounter
3. The Participants to this training are the identified receiving teachers for children with special needs in the elementary and secondary schools who has the ability to echo the training in their respective schools and could provide technical assistance to their fellow receiving teachers.
4. Snacks and meals shall be shouldered by the participants.
5. The participants, trainers and staff who will be involved in this activity shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, non-teaching staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time-Off (CTO), as per Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 entitled Non-monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
6. The Participants are also advised to prepare their authority to travel.
