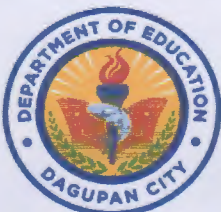

Subject: **CONDUCT OF VARIOUS ACTIVITIES FOR OPLAN KALUSUGAN SA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (OK SA DEPED)**

Pursuant to Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 28, s. 2018 titled "Policy and Guidelines on Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd)," all public schools nationwide are encouraged to observe the **OK sa DepEd One Health Week on January 20-24, 2020** focusing on **Health and Nutrition Education**.

The One Health Week will roll out a set of health activities featuring, but not limited to, the six major DepEd school health programs:

- School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP);
- National Drug Education Program (NDEP);
- Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) Program;
- Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program;
- Medical, Nursing, and Dental Services; and
- School Mental Health Program.

During the One Health Week, all Regional Offices, Schools Division Offices, and elementary and secondary schools are enjoined to undertake the following suggested activities, among others:

- Orientation of parents, communities, partners, and other stakeholders;
- Exhibits/fora on health and nutrition education, maintaining healthy lifestyle, good grooming and personal hygiene, NDEP, ARH, school mental health, and comprehensive tobacco control;
- Film showing on health and nutrition-related issues;
- Physical activities/exercises to promote healthy lifestyle; and
- Posting/Distribution of IEC materials such as leaflets, posters, advisories, etc.

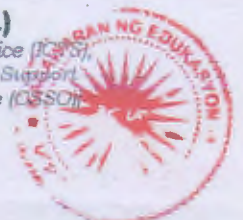

One Health Week shall be maximized to mobilize the community and promote collaboration with partners and stakeholders, especially at the school level. As such, the schools are tasked to coordinate with their division health personnel for the conduct of activities for One Health Week and network with partners within their localities for various health endeavors.

All offices and schools are reminded of existing policies governing partnerships, including the prohibition on institutional endorsements of products and services per DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2009; guidelines on engaging with companies that manufacture carbonated beverages per DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2017; prohibition on unnecessary interaction with the tobacco industry and its front NGOs per DepEd Order No. 48, s. 2016; and prohibition on partnership with milk companies Executive Order No. 51, s. 1986.

Regional and Schools Division Offices are expected to lead and ensure the conduct of One Health Week in all schools.

For reporting purposes, the schools shall ensure the documentation of the activities conducted during the One Health Week, following the data requirements of the *OK sa DepEd* Forms A and B attached to DO 28, s. 2018.
