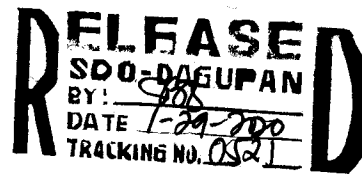




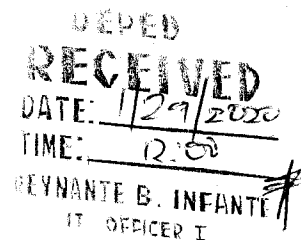

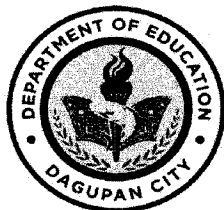

Subject: **ATTENDANCE AND PARTICIPATION TO 2-DAY RE-ECHO WORKSHOP ON KEEPING THE PHILIPPINES COMPETITIVE IN ENGLISH**

1. In line with the objectives of the DepEd Order 42, S. 2017 – National Adoption and Implementation of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers, the Schools Division Office of Dagupan City will be conducting a 2-day re-echo workshop on Keeping the Philippines Competitive in English Program on January 31 - February 1, 2020 to be held at E-Library (1st day) and West Central Elementary School I (day 2).
2. "Keeping the Philippines Competitive in English" is a tailored professional development program of the US Embassy conducted by the Texas International Education Consortium (TIEC) focused on teaching English as a second language and as medium of instruction in teaching English, Math and Science. This program is also intended to build teachers' capacities in educating multilingual communities and enhance their knowledge on proper implementation of the different strategies to be used for learners with language diversity.
3. This training will also be conducted to intensify the reading program in every school in the division which the primary objective is to create classroom libraries that are functional and to capacitate teachers on giving proper intervention to learners especially in the frustration level.
4. This training program aims to enable the participants to:
 - Enhance their knowledge on the different strategies in teaching English, Math and Science subjects



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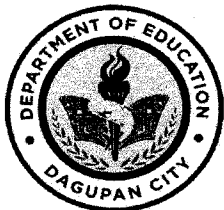

- Capacitate the teachers with innovative teaching techniques/strategies in educating multilingual communities
 - Recognize the importance of differentiated instruction in facilitating diverse learning and understand that reading is vital in teaching and learning process across different learning areas.
