- As per DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2019 entitled "School Calendar for School Year 2019 – 2020, this Office reminds all public elementary and secondary schools in the division on the conduct of the following activities:
 - March 12-13, 2020 (Thursday & Friday)-Fourth Quarter Examinations (Final Examinations for Grades 6 and 12)
 - March 19-20, 2020 (Thursday & Friday)- Fourth Quarter Examinations (Final Examinations for Grades 1-5 & Grades 7-11)
- This is also to reiterate the **Regional Policy on the Administration of Quarterly Examinations in Public Schools through Regional Order No. 1, s. 2017** which states the following:
 - ✓ that the quarterly examination measures whether learners have met the content and performance standards at the end of a period of learning. That in order for assessment to be more meaningful and authentic, teachers must use methods to measure student learning that have been deliberately designed to assess how well students have learned and able to apply their learning in different contexts;
 - ✓ only teacher made test shall be administered to the learners, not test constructed by assigned group in the division;
 - ✓ the results of the assessment test are **recorded and used** to report on the learner's achievements, the same are primarily reported to the learners and to the parents/guardians; and
 - ✓ quarterly examinations shall be monitored by the Regional and Division teams.



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3. The Office directs all Chief Education Supervisors, EPSs, PSDSs and SGOD Personnel to monitor the conduct of the Fourth Quarter Examinations and submit a Monitoring Report to the (SMME) Unit of the SDO c/o Mr. Isagani D. Rosario/Dr. Edgar T. Timbol on **March 23, 2020** for consolidation and submission to the Quality Assurance Division, DepEd Regional Office I on or before **March 25, 2020**. The report should contain among others the general conduct of the Fourth Quarter Examination, manner of reproduction of test materials, involvement of Teachers in the preparation of the test, source of fund for the reproduction of test materials and other issues and challenges in the conduct of the quarterly examinations as stated in the said Regional Memorandum. It is likewise reiterated that the attached monitoring tool be completely filled up by the monitoring officials/team members.
4. In relation to this, there will be an orientation of all monitoring official/team members on **March 10, 2020 (Tuesday), 3 o'clock** in the afternoon at the **SGOD Office**.
5. Attached is the assignment of the monitoring officials.
6. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is enjoined.



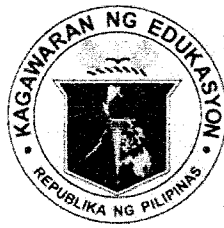
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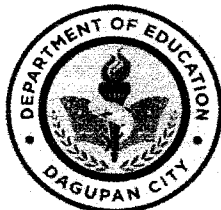

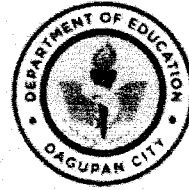

1. Having been mandated by Republic Act No. 9155 otherwise known as the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001, the Department of Education (DepEd) continuously conducts education research studies that serve as bases for necessary reforms and development.

2. DepEd has recently launched *Sulong Edukalidad*, a national campaign that aims to consolidate the efforts of all stakeholders to raise the quality of basic education in the country.

3. Moreover, DepEd continuously improves its programs and policies by advocating for strengthened evidence-based decision-making. In this connection, DepEd continues its conduct of **Research O'clock** from February to November 2020 at the *Buwagan ng Karunungan*, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City. The specific schedules, themes, and indicative topics are provided in the enclosure.

4. This forum primarily seeks to promote the use of research results and evidence in decision-making, program designing and implementation, plan formulation, and adjustment. Specifically, it aims to

- a. provide a venue for DepEd offices to learn from research studies from different sectors and organizations; and
- b. promote open discussions and continuous learning experiences for education leaders, researchers, policy makers, and educators in the basic education sector.

5. Selected research studies from the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) facility and studies conducted by partner organizations (e.g., research institutions and academe) will be presented. After each research presentation, a policy dialogue will be conducted to gather more insights about addressing education issues and concerns that emerge from the laid presentation.

6. All DepEd personnel, research practitioners, research enthusiasts, policy makers, program managers, and individuals with interest in specific education issues or topics covered by Research O'clock 2020 are invited to attend the forum. Details are provided in the Enclosure.
