

In support of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) and the Department of Education (DepEd), which was signed on February 9, 2013, the NCCA and the Arts Research and Training Institute in Southern Tagalog, Inc. (ARTIST, Inc.) in collaboration with the Linang Arts and Culture Network Inc. announce the 7th Malikhaing Guro International Conference on Culture-Based Education, which will be held on October 10, 17 and 24, 2020. In compliance with the COVID19 pandemic health protocols of the Philippine government, the conference will be conducted through video conferencing.
- 2. This year's theme is "Cultural Education: Bridging School and Community for Empowered Citizenry". The purpose of the conference is to gather cultural educators, pedagogues, cultural workers, and arts practitioners across nations and surface their various practices, emerging perspectives, and challenges to the different modalities and contexts of education anchored on culture.
- 3. With the conference theme as the general framework, paper presentations are expected to demonstrate reflections, conceptualization, or arguments on the following topics:
 - a. Case studies on school and community partnerships with focus on models of good practice, e.g. School governing Council, and other forms of school-based community management projects)
 - b. Concept paper on school-community partnership using cultural education as platform
 - c. Syntheses of experiences on Alternative Learning System (ALS) that highlight approaches of community engagement in the program
 - d. Dynamics and challenges in inter- and cross- cultural exchanges in culturally diverse community
- e. Innovative approaches, programs on cultural education in schools and community engaged by teachers and other cultural workers

 Special topics:
 - - a. Musings and actions on cultural education in time of pandemic
 - b. Case studies on efforts to continue cultural education during and beyond the time of pandemic

c. Case studies on the role of cultural education in assisting the community transcend the limits effected by the pandemic
