




Panimulat is a term derived from the phrase "Panimulang Pagmulat" that literally translates to initial awakening. Panimulat allows the students to make their first steps into the path of understanding the study of Development Communication. The main goal of the event is to let the participants understand the essence of giving importance to writing and reporting in order for them to educate not only themselves, but also the community.



DEVCOM CONFERENCE

PANIMULAT involves a comprehensive discussion tackling what Development Communication is about. This conference will focus on DevCom's concepts, values, and its importance when it comes to raising awareness about societal issues, especially those that concerns the marginalized sectors.



Participation and Registration

- 1. Interested schools may confirm their participation in PANIMULAT on or before March 1, 2021, by answering the letter of invitation sent via email.
- 2. Interested schools may also contact Nicole Boquiren at 0929 096 3707 for inquiries. You may also send an email at uplbdevcomsoc.inc@gmail.com.
- 3. After confirming your participation in PANIMULAT, the school will be sent a confirmation email containing the registration links for the essay contest participants along with the ZOOM credentials of the event.

General Guidelines

- 1. There is no entry or submission fee required for joining the essay competition.
- 2. The essay competition is open to all High Schools and Colleges with Senior High School programs.
- 3. Participants of the essay competition must be Grade 11 students of schools who have confirmed their participation in PANIMULAT.
- 4. Participants can come from any senior high school strand. Participating schools may send up to **two (2) participants** for the essay contest. However, participants will submit individual entries.
- 5. Only one (1) entry per participant is allowed.
- 6. The period of submission of entries will start on February 23, 2021 and will end on March 10, 2021.
- 7 The winners will be announced during the conference

Essay Contest Guidelines

- All essay entries should be written according to the prompt "How do you envision development?"
- Entries should be written in either English or Filipino language.
- Entries should have a minimum of 1000 words and a maximum of 1500 words.
- Entries should be the participant's original work;
 plagiarism will not be tolerated and participants liable will be automatically disqualified.
 - If including a quote or phrase of another work, use the APA citation style and include references/bibliography.
- Entries should be electronically typewritten and submitted according to the following format:

Font: Times New Roman

o Font Size: 12 pt.

Margin: 1" on all sides


Line Spacing: Double Spaced

Essay Contest Guidelines

- Participants should include their Full Name, Name of School, Contact Number, and Email Address on the upper left-hand side corner of the first (1st) page.
- Entries should be submitted in the PDF format with the following file name format: Surname_EssayTitle.pdf
- A panel of judges will choose the winning entries based on these criteria. The participants with the Top 3 winning entries will be announced during the PANIMULAT online conference on March 17, 2021 and will be declared the 1st place winner, 2nd place winner, and 3rd place winner respectively. The decision of the panel of judges will be considered final and irrevocable.
