SDO DC carries out SBFP

To guarantee the learner's health amidst pandemic, the Schools Division Office of Dagupan devised a way to continue the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) this school vear.

The Department of Education (DepEd) sent out guidelines regarding the implementation of the (SBFP) Milk feeding component. It aims to provide nutrition to the beneficiaries of the program and develop healthy eating habits such as eating fruits and vegetables and drinking

The Covid-19 pandemic brought conditions that made the standard SBFP system difficult to apply. Despite these circumstances, SDO Dagupan's medical unit has pushed through with the program through a systematic way of delivering nutrition right to the participant's threshold. School SBFP representatives distribute the food products from school to the homes of the beneficiaries.

Moreover, school partners and LGUs also help in distributing the milk packs and nutritious food. As food and milk products make their way to the designated

> E-Nutribun, a type of vitamin and iron-enriched bread, other nutritious food products, and fresh or sterilized carabao's milk are given to the beneficiaries. These food products are produced by local farmers and bread makers to support their small businesses during the pandemic.

> With 6,135 beneficiaries from kindergarten to grade six learners across 34 public elementary schools located in the city, the program continues to provide nutrition and welfare.

> The SBFP-Milk Feeding component F.Y. 2019 started last November 3, 2020 and is expected to end on the third week of May.
