SUBJECT: DISTRICT SCOUTING COMMITTEE REORGANIZATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR 2021-2024

1. The Department of Education issued DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012 titled, "GUIDELINES ON REVITALIZING BOY SCOUTING IN SCHOOLS NATIONWIDE", stated that Scouting with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) is an effective co-curricular program in the leadership and value formation of every child, which is consistent with the DepEd's mission to develop every boy and every young man into a well-rounded individual with exemplary character worth the emulation of learners.
2. The DepEd SDO Dagupan City supports the revitalization of Scouting (Boy & Girl) in schools citywide in various areas of possible partnership & cooperation. As such, all DepEd officials & personnel are encouraged to be active members of the Scouting movements (BSP/GSP). All public and private elementary and secondary schools, through their school principals/heads are advised to promote membership, programs, activities and projects among learners, parents, teachers, other stakeholders and community.
3. In view of this, the REORGANIZATION and ELECTION of Scouting Committees in the schools and districts is hereby scheduled to be conducted within the 1st week of July and for the BSP Dagupan City Council to schedule its election of the Council Executive Board on the 3rd week of the same month.
4. The *Standard Local Council Constitution and Bylaws of the BSP, Article VII, Sections 20-21* provides that *the local area/territory shall be divided geographically/strategically into scouting districts where it shall have an organized and functional School & District Scouting Committees and shall elect its officers, a District Chairman, two (2) Vice-Chairmen, Treasurer, and Auditor. While the District Scouting Coordinator is mandated/appointed as Secretary.*



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5. The Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) assigned in the areas covering the schools mentioned in item 6, shall lead/supervise and monitor the conduct of the District Reorganization and see to it that it is properly disseminated, attended, and make sure that an orderly conduct of the election is observed.

6. Per consultation with the stakeholders, this Office recommends the re-districting of all schools both public and private into the following:
