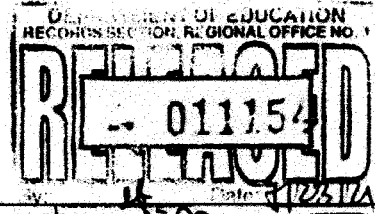

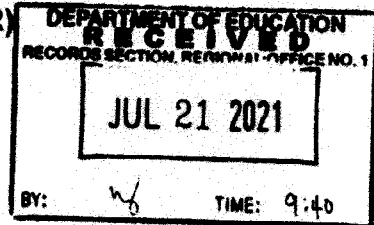

The **Philippine Center for Gifted Education, Inc. (PCGE)** is a non-stock, non-profit organization advocating for equitable access to programs and services in gifted education in the Philippines, particularly in the areas of identification and nurturing of the potentially gifted.

This year, we are celebrating PCGE's 10th year anniversary with the theme: **"Pillipinong Pantas, Alab ng Pagbabago – Handog ng PCGE sa Sambayanan at sa Mundo"**.

Our annual celebration is made more significant because we shall award the *Mga Bagong Rizal (MBR)*. The MBR Search, a biennial and flagship program of the PCGE, was first launched in 2011. It aims to identify, recognize and help further develop high-ability and potentially gifted Filipino youths in the areas of cognition, the arts, creativity and leadership, and other multiple intelligences, and foster in them the mindset of commitment in helping towards national development. PCGE awarded, in the past 10 years and 5 searches, 103 Filipino youths from more than a thousand nominees across the country. A number of them are already professionals and the majority are in schools in the Philippines and abroad pursuing their various programs of study.

The nominees may be elementary pupils (at least Grade 5 level) to college students, or out-of-school youths and ALS students not older than 22 years old.

Awardees would be part of the PCGE leadership and mentoring program that would further develop them holistically, and foster in them the mindset of service to the nation. Subsequently, they will become part of the PCGE-MBR sustainable program and structure through which their conceptualized advocacy and empowerment projects may be implemented.
