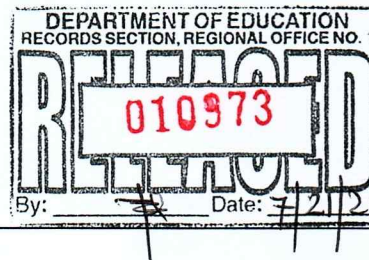

Deadline of submission of entries is on or before **September 25, 2021**. Entries should be covered in plastic upon submission. Each participant can submit a maximum of two (2) entries. Two-time winners of previous ABKD competitions can no longer join. Poster that have won or have been submitted to other contest will not be accepted.

Two (2) major prize winners and four (4) winners from each category will be selected. Winning entries shall be informed through phone or letter. Awarding shall be done online. Major prize winners shall receive P 5,000 each while other winning entries shall receive P1,000 each. Winning poster shall become CDRC property and will be featured in the 2022 CDRC Calendar and other promotional materials.

Non-winning entries can be claimed at the CDRC office. Entries not claimed within 60 days after the announcement of winners shall be considered donations to CDRC.

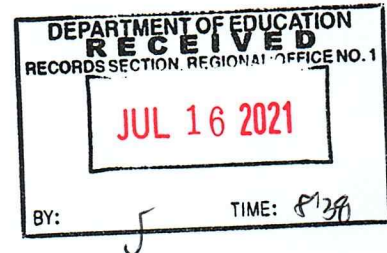

WINNERS

Two (2) major prize winners and four winners from each category will be selected. Winner will be informed through phone or letter, and will be awarded in an online event (date to be announced). Major prize winners will get P5,000 each. Other winners will receive P1,000 each. Prizes not claimed within six (6) months will be forfeited. Winning posters shall become CDRC property and will be featured in the 2020 CDRC Calendar and other promotional materials. Non-winning entries can be reclaimed at the CDRC office. Entries not claimed within 60 days after the announcement of winners shall be considered donations to CDRC.

CONTEST LIMITS

Each participant can submit a maximum of two (2) entries.
Two-time winners of previous ABKD competitions can no longer join.
Posters that have won or have been submitted to other contests will not be accepted.
