



## GFPS holds HGDG webinar

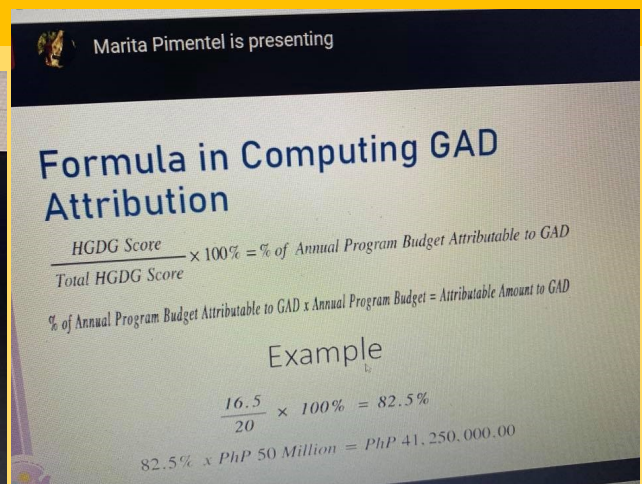
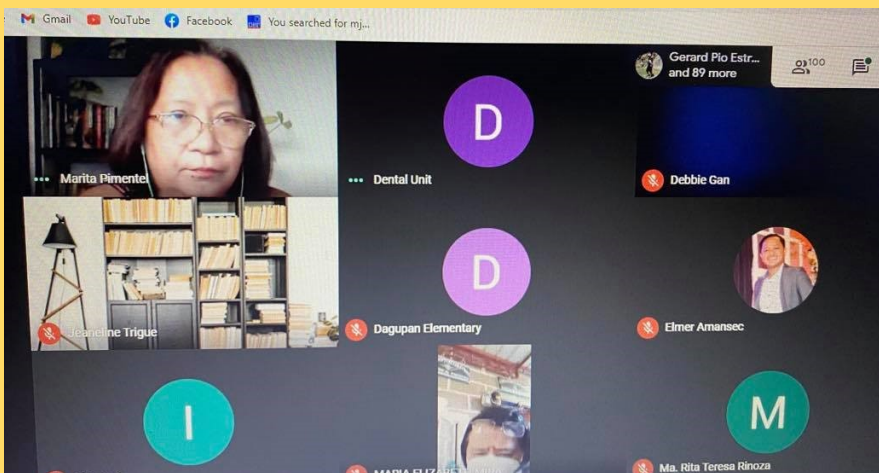

The webinar also aimed to create awareness among all SDO GFPS and school heads on the significance and mechanics of HG DG and GAD fund attribution.

Mrs. Marita Castillo-Pimentel, a member of the National Resource Pool of the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) discussed the HG DG tool to ensure that programs and projects undertaken by the government in their various stages are gender-responsive. Elements of a gender-

It is also noted that HG DG is the only tool allowed by the Commission on Audit as a reference for PPA attribution. Users of HG DG are program and project developers, implementers monitoring and evaluation (M&E) team, as well as the GFPS. Some of the agency's PPA such as Brigada Eskwela, Gulayan sa Paaralan Program, School-Based Feeding Program, Dental Health Care Program, learning materials, may be attributed to GAD.
