STORYBOOK MAKING CONTEST MECHANICS

I. Participants

Story writing enthusiasts aged 14 and above residing in Region 1.

II. Theme: “Kabataan, Maging mulat sa Kalusugang Pangkaisipan!”

The aim of this storybook making contest is to explain and promote Mental Health Awareness to school-age children in a creative and age-appropriate manner.

III. Deadline of Entries: October 1, 2021 4:00 PM

IV. Mechanics:

1. Each contestant is entitled to submit one (1) entry in hardcopy or in digital form.
2. Contestants may join solo or as a group (maximum of 3 members)
3. Entry must be the contestant’s original work reflecting age-appropriate, science-based, gender and culture-sensitive concepts in explaining mental health.
4. Storybook must have a minimum of 5 pages but not more than 10 pages (inclusive of illustration and text).
 - a. **Paper Size: A4**
5. Storybook must be written in Filipino language.
6. Should not contain any offensive or inappropriate language, image and/or content.
7. Entry must not have been joined in any story writing contests and/or commercially published or used in any media platform.
8. The **top 3 winners** will be selected by the judges based on the criteria set by the program.
9. The winners shall be notified through email and the contact number provided and shall be announced during the **“Healthy Usapan”** Facebook Live session through the **Ilocos Center For Health Development** Facebook Page.
10. All entries shall become the property of DOH CHD- I
11. By entering the competition, the entrant/s and their legal guardian, agrees that the entrant/s full name/s will be published with the storybook, including copies which may be donated to other organizations for advocacy purposes.
12. Criteria for judging:

Originality of content and adherence to the theme	50%
Clarity of message	30%
Creativity and aesthetic quality of illustrations	20%
Total:	100%



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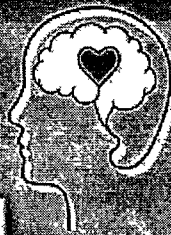

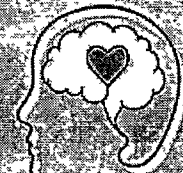
