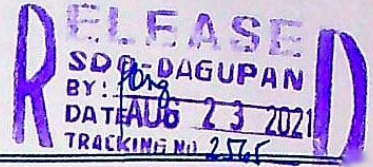

SUBJECT: **REVISED REDISTRICTING FOR THE BOY/GIRL SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES**

DATE: 23 AUGUST 2021

1. With the issuance of the DM Memo No. 221, s. 2021, "CLUSTER OF SCHOOLS UNDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND INSTRUCTIONAL SUPERVISION OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS DISTRICT SUPERVISORS", the scouting community will therefore align its scouting district committees for a better and more efficient monitoring and supervision of its programs and activities.
2. The previously issued Division Memorandum No. 168, s. 2021, "DISTRICT SCOUTING COMMITTEE REORGANIZATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR 2021-2024" regarding the Re-organization and re-districting of scouting committees will now be recalled and rescinded and shall be guided with DM No. 221, s. 2021. The scouting districts will now become eleven (11) instead of seven (7).
3. The PSDSs/EPS in-charge of the districts shall initiate the organization and selection of the BSP District Scouting Committees to include the Private schools, as soon as possible. All schools have already organized their school scouting committees with their officers, except the private schools. The PSDS's/EPS and the Institutional Heads/principals becomes the district committee advisers.
4. Per BSP Standard Local Council Constitution and Bylaws, ALL the District Scouting Committee Chairmen including the Schools Division Superintendent as the BSP Council Scout Commissioner, the President of the GSP Local Council Board and two (2) Scout representatives are mandated members of the BSP Local Council Board. Other council members will be nominated at large from the lay leaders/private sector and other supportive community leaders.
