

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 43 Series of 2021

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER PRESCRIBING HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES IN CONFORMITY WITH THE ALERT LEVEL 2 COMMUNITY QUARANTINE CLASSIFICATION FOR THE CITY OF DAGUPAN

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) issued the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines (IATF Omnibus Guidelines), as amended, to harmonize and codify existing guidelines of the IATF and member-agencies pertaining to community quarantine, which shall be applied to all regions, provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays placed under community quarantine;

WHEREAS, the Guidelines for the Pilot Implementation of Alert Levels System in the National Capital Region was adopted by the IATF and was published on 13 September 2021;

WHEREAS, the pilot area for implementation of the Alert Levels System was expanded to include other provinces, highly urbanized cities, and independent component cities pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 144-D (s.2021) issued on 18 October 2021;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 151 (s. 2021), signed by the President and issued on 11 November 2021, approved the nationwide rollout of the Alert Level System and adopted these Guidelines as the guidelines to be implemented and enforced in all areas under the Alert Level System;

WHEREAS, the City of Dagupan, under IATF Resolution No. 148-F dated 13 November 2021, has been placed under Alert Level 2 until 30 November 2021;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prescribe new guidelines in conformity with the Alert Level 2 Classification for the City of Dagupan essential to the promotion of the general welfare, health, and safety of the public;

NOW THEREFORE, I, MARC BRIAN C. LIM, City Mayor of Dagupan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the Philippines, do hereby declare the following health and safety guidelines in Dagupan during such period that the City is under Alert Level 2 Community Quarantine Status:

 The following establishments, or activities, shall be allowed to operate, or be undertaken at a maximum of 50% indoor venue capacity for fully vaccinated individuals and those below 18 years of age, even if unvaccinated, and 70% outdoor venue capacity. Provided, that all workers/employees of these establishments are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and minimum public health standadrs shall be strictly maintained.

- a) Venues for meetings, incentives, conferences, and exhibitions;
- b) Permitted **venues for social events such as parties**, wedding receptions, engagement parties, wedding anniversaries, debut and birthday parties, family reunions, and bridal or baby showers;
- c) Visitor or tourist attractions such as libraries, archives, museums, galleries, exhibits, parks, plazas, public gardens, scenic viewpoints or overlooks, and the like:
- d) Amusement parks, including kid amusement industries such as playgrounds, playroom, and kiddie rides, and recreational venues such as internet cafes, billiard halls, amusement arcades, bowling alleys, swimming pools, and similar venues;
- e) Cinemas and movie houses;
- f) Limited face-to-face or in-person classes for basic education, subject to prior approval of the Office of the President;
- g) Limited face-to-face or in-person classes for higher education and for technical-vocational education and training, subject to approval and guidelines from the Commission on Higher Education (CHE) and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA);
- h) In-person religious gatherings; gatherings for necrological services, wakes, inurnment, and funerals for those who died of causes other than Covid-19 and for the cremains of the Covid-19 deceased;
- Licensure or entrance/qualifying examinations administered by their respective government agency, and specialty examinations authorized by the IATF subject to the health and safety guidelines as approved by the IATF;
- j) **Dine-in food services** such as kiosks, commissaries, restaurants, and eateries, subject to DTI sector-specific protocols;
- k) Personal care establishments such as barbershops, hair spas, hair salons, and nail spas, and those offering aesthetic/cosmetic services or procedures, make-up services, salons, spas, reflexology, and other similar procedures including home service options, subject to the sector-specific protocols of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI);
- Fitness studios, gyms, and venues for individual non-contact exercise and sports, provided that patrons/clients and workers/employees wear face masks at all times and subject to DTI sector-specific protocols;
- m) Film, music, and television production subject to the joint guidelines as may be issued by the DTI, DOLE, and the DOH;

- n) Venues with live voice or wind-instrument performers and audiences such as in karaoke bars, clubs, concert halls, and theaters; and
- o) Gatherings in residences with individuals not belonging to the same household.
- 2. For purposes of obtaining **S-Pass to enter Dagupan**, the following documents shall be required for its approval
 - a) Valid and verifiable vaccination card indicating that the individual have been fully vaccinated. In the absence of said vaccination card, the individual shall submit a negative RT-PCR or Antigen test not more than three (3) days old prior to entry to Dagupan; and
 - b) Any government-issued or valid identification card.
- Cockfighting and operation of cockpits, and other gaming establishments, shall not be allowed to operate, or be undertaken, except as may be authorized by the IATF or the Office of the President.
- 4. The use of face shields shall be voluntary, without prejudice to establishments adopting guidelines requiring the use of face shield within their premises.
- 5. The ban on the serving and public consumption of liquor and alcoholic beverages in the City of Dagupan is hereby lifted effective immediately, unless subsequently prohibited by separate issuances. The permission on the selling and distribution of liquor and alcoholic beverages in the City of Dagupan remains effective.
- 6. The Bike and Run Day every Sunday shall resume, subject to guidelines that will be adopted by the Dagupan City Sports Commission.
- 7. Curfew in the City of Dagupan remains to be between 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. However, effective November 22, 2021, the curfew hours will be shortened to 12:00 MN to 3:00 a.m., provided that the curfew hours may be shortened or extended depending on the actual public health situation on a given period.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately, unless otherwise herein provided.
