

Participants: Registration Fee: Boy Scouts, Senior Scouts, Troop Leaders and Outfit Advisors A minimal fee of One Hundred Pesos shall be charge each participants to defray expenses on zoom application (each

council shall have 500people zoom subscription), Jamboree Patch, program materials for demonstration, certificates prizes, Load for the Jamboree Staff and meals for the Council Staff convening for purposes of monitoring, evaluation and

meetings.

- Participation shall be one adult and two scouts, each is given their own respective zoom. No Adult Leader is allowed to participate and pay registration unless pays the equivalent of three participants. Payment shall be received by the local councils which will be directly disbursed by them.
- Scouts will camp as expected. They will have their own tent pitch at their own backyard and conduct development and places in the camp all required projects the staff would require them to do during offline activities.
- 4. There will be six modules for the scouts and leaders to actively participate and complete requirements. These will through blended mode. All the materials listed for each module shall be produced by the Scouts and Adult Leaders. These will be checked by the Council Contingent Team prior to the start of the modules for the day. List will be issued to the councils to be disseminated to their respective participants. Except those that are to be spoiled, materials shall be made available two days before the event.

- 5. We will also have ancillary activities like Scout Quiz Bee, Scout Youth Forum, Woodbadge Reunion, Scout's Talent Discovery and Eagle Scout Conclave to strengthen the camaraderie of the young people, prove each has unique talent, instill the memories of training courses and many more.
- 6. Submission of projects shall be on daily basis as required. The Council Management Team shall monitor the submission of the projects which will eventually forward to the Regional Management Team. This will be the basis of issuance of Certificate of Participation to all scouts and leaders participating.
- 7. Other information with respect to modules and ancillary activities will be issued from time to time. These information will also be posted in the Ilocos Region's Official Facebook Account https://www.facebook.com/ilocos.region.520.
