

COURSE PROPOSAL FOR SDO DAGUPAN TEACHERS AND SCHOOL

LEADERS

- In line with DepEd Order No. 1, s. 2020 titled Guidelines for the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) Recognition of Professional Development Program and Course for Teacher and School Leaders and DepEd Memorandum No. 50, s. 2020 titled DepEd Professional Development Priorities for Teachers and School Leaders, the Schools Division Office announces the opening the submission of proposals.
- The call is open to all SDO Supervisors and Unit Heads. The School Heads are enjoined to submit their INSET Proposal for SY 2021-2022.
- 3. Proposal shall be evaluated based on the following criteria stated in DO 001, s. 2020:
 - Alignment with the EAP Professional Development Priorities, as stated in DepEd Memorandum no. 050, s. 2020;
 - Mapping of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST), the Philippine Professional Standards for School Heads (PPSSH), or the Philippine Professional Standards for Supervisors (PPST);
 - Articulation of Objectives/Outcomes
 - Alignment of the Objectives/Intended Learning Outcomes (ILOs).
 Content and, if applicable, Assessment with the professional standards for teachers or school leaders;
 - Soundness of Methodology;



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- Mechanisms to determine whether the Objectives/ILOs have been met;
- · Strength of Research-base;
- · Use of Adult Learning Principles;
- Use of Recognized Best Practices;
- Intended Classroom Level Application and Innovation;
- · Credentials/Expertise of Resource Person/s; and
- Budget and Costing and Absorptive Capacity.
- All applicants can access the updated soft copies of Authorization and Recognition Application Forms at https://bit.ly/eLSPForms. All required documents shall be submitted on January 31, 2022.
- An intensive Orientation will be conducted on January 13, 2022 at 1:30 in the afternoon via Zoom.
- For SDO Supervisor and Personnel approved training designs could be charged in the GAA-HRD while the school-based trainings will be charged from the school's INSET Fund.
- Attached is the Professional Development (PD) Priorities for Teachers SY 2020 to 2023. School heads are also advised to take into consideration the learning and development needs they have identified with the triangulation of the results of the E-SAT, IPCRF and consolidated Development Plan.
