

- The DepEd Public Affairs Service (PAS) is soliciting personal stories and essays on the achievements of DepEd in the last six (6) years. It will serve as a memoir of the Department during the leadership of Secretary Leonor Magtolis Briones.
- Division Information Officers (DIOs) and School Information Coordinators (SICs) are requested
 to compile and submit stories and testimonials (in Word format) written by learners, parents,
 teachers, non-teaching personnel, and officials of the Division.
- 3. The story of testimonials must:
 - a. be written in English or Filipino
 - b. be strictly 1,000-1,300 words only (excluding the title)
 - c. have acompanying photo/s (in .jpg/ .png format)
- 4. The stories must tackle initiatives under Secretary Briones' 10 Point Agenda:

a. Implementation of K-12;

- Enrichment of curricula in three areas: strengthening of drug education component; strengthening of gender and development component, especially in relation to teenaged pregnany and HIV-AIDS; and special emphasis on environmental awareness, disaster preparedness and climate change adaptation and mitigation;

- e. Enriched curricular and non-curricular programs;
