

REITERATION OF NATIONAL DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM (NDEP)

IMPLEMENTATION IN SCHOOLS

- Pursuant to Section 43 of Article IV of R.A. No. 9165 otherwise known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002," the Department of Education reiterates its support to the National Drug Education Program (NDEP).
- The following Memoranda/Orders were also issued that aims to develop well-rounded learners equipped with resistance skills against risky behaviors that could lead to substance use and abuse.

- Strengthening the NDEP in Schools
- Preventive Drug Education Program Policy on Curriculum and Instruction
- Implementation of Detailed Lesson Plan on Preventive Drug Education

3. Schools must:

- Organize NDEP corners and information, education and communication (IEC) materials located in appropriate area
- b. Designate school NDEP coordinator.
- Ensure the involvement of PTA and student organizations in drug prevention activities.
- d. Conduct drug lectures or symposium.
- e. Coordinate with GO's and NGO's in any of the following: Barangay Anti Drug Abuse Council (BADAC), DOH, LGU, PNP and or others.
- 4. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this memorandum is desired.
